










SOURCE OF OSU NEW FRESHMEN BY RESIDENT STATUS FALL SEMESTER 1983






SOURCE OF OSU UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS FALL SEMESTER 1983






SOURCE OF OSU GRADUATE STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS FALL SEMESTER 1983







SOURCE OF MINORITY STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS FALL SEMESTER 1983















PERCENT OF USU NEW FRESHMEN IN VARIOUS ACT COMPOSITE INTERVALS FALL SEMESTER 1983









High School Grade Point Average













AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF USU STUDENTS BY COLLEGE FALL SEMESTER 1983





OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

The OSU undergraduate student body during the 1970's was composed of about 90% resident and 10% non-resident students. This has changed for the past three Fall Semesters to 88% and 12%, respectively for Fall 1981 and for the Fall Semesters of 1982 and 1983, this distribution has changed to approximately 87% and 13%, respectively. This change has a small effect on our enrollment projection models which have been used in the past.

The new freshman class each Fall Semester usually follows the residency distribution pattern of the total undergraduate student body. This also proved to be true for the Fall Semester of 1983. Since 88.5% of the new freshmen class are resident students, the public high schools of Oklahoma are Oklahoma State University's major source of students. Therefore, our enrollment projections must have the projection of Oklahoma public high school graduates as its basis.

Each year the Oklahoma State Department of Public Education publishes a report illustrating the flow of students in public school systems of Oklahoma. This document is the source from which we have projected Oklahoma public high school graduates for the next seven years in order to project the new freshmen class at Oklahoma State University. Upon reviewing the Department of Public Education's report, it would appear that an in-migration has occurred in the middle grades of the Oklahoma public school system over the past couple of years. This did occur during a high employment period, thus with the high unemployment rate which we are now experiencing in Oklahoma, one may expect an out-migration to occur in the next couple of years. If this assumption is true, we will need to revise the projected number of high school graduates for 1988, 1989, and 1990. As the table on page 86 will illustrate, the projection


of 41,354 public high school graduates would be the largest number of seniors to ever graduate in Oklahoma.

A retention study is done each fall illustrating the flow of students from class to class with respect to the previous fall semester to the present fall semester. Upon reviewing these studies, one finds the retention of a specific class varies little from year to year, but the distribution of the students to different classes varies more. Example: For the Fall Semester of 1979, 68.2% of the freshmen class returned the following fall of 1980; for the 1978 fall semester, 68.2% of the freshmen returned the following fall of 1979; but in 1980, 11.8% of the freshmen from the previous year were classified as freshmen, while in 1979, 14.3% of the previous year's freshmen were classified as freshmen. For 1982, 66.2% of the fall freshmen class of 1982 returned in the fall of 1983, but 14.8% of them were classified as freshmen which is different when compared to the same statistics for 1979 and 1980.

Using this information as the basis for the projection models, one can develop models which project the overall retention better than a particular group advancing to the next class. This method decreases the amount of error when projecting total headcount.

Graduate enrollment is not easy to project with respect to the same variables as undergraduate enrollment. The job market (which many believe has had a more than usual effect on Fall 1983 enrollment), the unemployment rate for Oklahoma (which is much higher than usual), the amount of available funding for graduate students from departments and the emphasis of the departments on recruiting graduate students are major factors affecting enrollment and must be taken into consideration when making projections. Input by the graduate dean on policy and future funding is reflected in the graduate enrollment projections.

- (C) All Oklahoma Public Institutions First Time Freshmen



GLOSSARY

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes new freshmen, other freshmen, sophomores, juniors, seniors, special undergraduates, special graduates, masters, doctorates, Veterinary Medicine students, and Educational TV students.

College

The university is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agriculture (Ag); Arts and Sciences (A & S); Business Administration (Bus); Education (Educ); Engineering, Technology and Architecture (CEAT); and Home Economics (HE).

Data for Engineering, Technology and Architecture are sometimes divided into two data sets—one for the School of Technology (Tech Inst or School of Tech), and the second for Engineering and Architecture (Engr).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, there are the Graduate College and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Educational TV Student

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa (see Student Location).

Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU excluding non-resident aliens (Non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

White: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Europe (except Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia and Iran.

Black: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Africa south of the Sahara.

Native American: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of North and South America.

Hispanic: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Spain and Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spainards, and Portuguese.

Asian: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the <u>Pacific Islands</u>. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian sub-continent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (<u>including</u> non-resident aliens), some tables and figures which present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the non-resident alien population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a

non-resident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission the student is categorized as a non-resident alien.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is one who has not yet selected a major. A special graduate student is a student with a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university who is admitted to the graduate college and is taking courses at OSU, but who does not have immediate plans to become a degree candidate.

Student Location

Beginning with Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File is defined by one of the following Student Location codes:

- O Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
- 1 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking OSU courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCAT)
- 2 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCAT)

- 3 Enrolled in OSU courses only through the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back Television system (EDTV or ETV or Educational TV students)
- 4 Enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV and also at the University Center at Tulsa (ETV + UCAT)
- 5 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV (OSU + ETV)
- 6 Enrolled in OSU courses on the main campus, through Educational TV and at University Center at Tulsa (OSU + ETV + UCAT)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCAT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5 and 6 above).

Type of Admission

New students admitted to OSU are classified as a new freshman, a transfer student or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).
