

INTRODUCTION

The Office of Institutional Research, together with the Users Advisory Committee, presents the tenth publication of the Oklahoma State University Student Profile. Our objective in producing this document is to provide information on present, as well as previous, Oklahoma State University student enrollment. We attempt to depict trend data in a manner which is useful in planning for the challenges which lie ahead. This report is intended as an internal reference to help the University community better understand the University's most important resource--its students.

Some of the tables this year have been revised to include more information, or to be more easily understood. The Users Advisory Committee is to be commended for their continued support and advice. While the publication cannot contain all available information, it does present a comprehensive profile of most student information which has been requested by Oklahoma State University administrators.

This publication is intended as a "living document" to which additional information will be added each year. The document has become a very useful resource for student information to many departments and individuals at OSU. 







NON-RESIDENT UNDEGRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE



RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY

























ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY


Enrollment Change Over the Past Twelve Years (1978-89) (Expressed in Percentages)





AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GPA BY RACE AND SEX













OSU FALL SEMESTER ENROLLMENT HEADCOUNT PROJECTIONS

The new freshman enrollment for fall 1990 at Oklahoma State University is composed of 90.9% Oklahoma residents and 9.1% non-Oklahoma residents (including international students). The distribution of Oklahoma resident new freshmen increased more than 2% from last year (from 88.7%). The major cause of this shift in distribution was a decline in the number of U.S. out-of-state new freshmen from 233 in 1989 to 142 in 1990, a 40% reduction. Over the past ten years, the percentage of new freshmen who are Oklahoma residents has almost always been in the range of 87% to 89%, with year-to-year fluctuations of less than 1%. Therefore, the importance of forecasts of the number of Oklahoma high school graduates as a basis for forecasting OSU enrollments appears to be increasing.


The forecast of Oklahoma high school graduates used in this section is based on a report published by the Oklahoma State Department of Public Education which illustrates the flow of students in Oklahoma public school systems. The forecast assumes that demographic trends such as immigration into the state and emigration out of it will remain relatively constant. It appears that Oklahoma's economy has not started to decline, as has been experienced by some of the other southern states, so no massive exodus of parents with high school age children is foreseen.

Several factors currently complicate forecasting enrollment for OSU, particularly long-range forecasting. Most of these factors depend on policy decisions originating with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. First, the admission standards for the university are in the process of being raised. This will certainly reduce the "pool" of potential students eligible to attend Oklahoma State, but it is unclear whether students now eligible for admission will attend OSU in the same proportion as those formerly eligible, or if the ratio of actual enrollees to eligible students will rise or decline. Second, enrollment is strongly affected by the number of scholarships offered and by the effort put into high school recruiting. These factors have varied considerably in the past few years. Finally, there is an increased emphasis on the retention of current students, with new efforts including the strengthening of University Academic Services. The higher admissions standards being phased in should improve retention as well.

Because of the uncertainty caused by these factors, only projections for fall 1991 are included in this publication. The impact of changing admissions, retention, scholarship, and recruiting policies will require the passage of some time to be reflected in the data used as a basis for enrollment forecasts. As the impact of these policy changes becomes clear in the next few years, a new enrollment forecasting model will be developed and we will resume publishing long-range enrollment forecasts. The new model will include increased emphasis on the Delphi technique to incorporate the judgment and experience of OSU personnel closely involved with the enrollment process.

Even without a new forecasting model, it is clear that unless more emphasis is placed on student marketing and financial aid, OSU enrollments will continue to decline for the next four to six years. Since the university depends on Oklahoma high school graduates for approximately 90% of its undergraduate enrollment, the combination of higher admissions standards and declining numbers of high school graduates presents a clear challenge. While some gains may be possible from sources such as graduate students and non-resident undergraduates, it will be hard to compensate for the forecasted reductions in our major source of students. Major percentage gains in these small groups of students would be necessary to compensate for even small percentage declines in Oklahoma undergraduates.



GLOSSARY

Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 90. Therefore, students born in January 1970 and December 1970 will both be reported as age 20 (90-70).

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agriculture (AG); Arts and Sciences (AS); Business Administration (BU); Education (ED); Engineering, Technology and Architecture (CEAT); and Home Economics (HE). Data for Engineering, Technology and Architecture are sometimes divided into two data sets--one for the School of Technology (TI), and the second for Engineering and Architecture (EN).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, students may enroll in the University Academic Services, the Graduate College and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Educational TV Students

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa. A student who is enrolled in courses at OSU and who is also enrolled in an Educational TV course is counted as an OSU student (see Student Location).

Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU excluding non-resident aliens (Non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

White:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Europe (except Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia and Iran.

Black:

All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa south of the Sahara.

Native American:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of North and South America.

Hispanic:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Spain and Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spaniards, and Portuguese.

Asian:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian sub-continent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (including non-resident aliens), some tables and figures which present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the non-resident alien population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a non-resident. If

the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as a non-resident alien.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a non-degree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a non-degree seeking student admitted to the graduate college.

Student Location

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File is defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

- O Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
- 1 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCT)
- 2 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCT)
- 3 Enrolled in OSU courses only through the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back Television system (EDTV or ETV or Educational TV students)

- 4 Enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV and also at the University Center at Tulsa (ETV + UCT)
- 5 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV (OSU + ETV)
- 6 Enrolled in OSU courses on the main campus, through Educational TV and at University Center at Tulsa (OSU + ETV + UCT)
- 7 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at University Center at Enid. (UCE)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5 and 6 above).

Type of Admission

A new student admitted to OSU is classified as a new freshman, a transfer student or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).

Prior to Fall 1986, students admitted as adult specials were classified as transfer students. Beginning in Fall 1986, these students were classified as new freshmen students.
