

FALL 1995 OSU STUDENT PROFILE DATA AND TREND HIGHLIGHTS

GENERAL

- ◆ After 12 straight decreases, OSU's main campus enrollment *increased* from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995 (up 3.3%, from 17,784 to 18,378).
- ◆ Enrollment of new freshmen at OSU is up 13.5% over Fall 1994, while new transfer students increased 9.4%.
- ◆ Fall 1995 is the largest new freshman class since 1989.
- ◆ The percentage of the 1989 beginning freshman class graduating after 6 years increased from 45.5% to 49.1% over the 1985 beginning freshman class.
- ◆ OSU's market share of new Oklahoma resident freshmen increased from 5.9% in Fall 1994 to 6.1% in Fall 1995.
- ◆ After a steady decline over the past 13 years, OSU's enrollment as a percent of total enrollment in Oklahoma's institutions of higher education increased from 11.1% in 1994 to 11.5% in 1995.
- ◆ Counting all students (undergraduate and graduate), all 77 counties in Oklahoma, all 50 states, and 104 foreign countries are represented among OSU's student body.

STUDENT BODY

Source of Students

- ◆ Total *resident new freshmen* increased 11.4% from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995.
- ◆ New freshmen enrollment from Oklahoma's top two metro counties--Oklahoma and Tulsa--increased substantially from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995 (15.8% and 28.3%, respectively).
- ◆ Small schools (high school graduating classes of less than 50 students) account for an increasing percentage of new freshmen: 18.9% in Fall 1995 compared to 17.5% in Fall 1994 and 14.5% in Fall 1993.
- ◆ In Fall 1995, Stillwater High School provided twice as many new freshmen as the next highest feeder school. One hundred twenty-two new freshmen graduated from SHS, while 61 attended high school at Edmond High.
- ◆ OSU is drawing more out-of-state new freshmen from the south central region of the country. In Fall 1994, 156 new freshmen came from the six states that geographically border Oklahoma. In Fall 1995, that number increased to 188, an increase of 18.6%.
- ◆ Fall 1995 out-of-state new freshmen increased 26.5% from Fall 1994 (from 249 to 315).
- ◆ *Nonresident undergraduates* increased 12.3% from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995.

Composition of Student Body

- ♦ For the first time in OSU's history, enrollment of out-of-state students exceeds 20%.
- ♦ For the first time in six years, new freshmen comprise over 13% of OSU's student body.
- ♦ For the first time in OSU's recorded history, graduate students (excluding Special Graduates) make up over 17% of OSU's student body.
- ♦ The total number of graduate students increased 8.4% from Fall 1990 to Fall 1995.
- ♦ Over the past 20 years, OSU's graduate student enrollment has been higher than Fall 1995's 3,664 figure only two times (in 1987 with 3,678 and in 1992 with 3,759).
- ♦ The percentage of minority students has risen for seven straight years, increasing to 22.2% of the student body this fall.
- ♦ During the past 10 years, Native American enrollment has increased 153%, Hispanic 69.6%, and Asian 42.5%; however, African-American enrollment has decreased 20.8%.
- ♦ Out-of-state and nonresident alien enrollment has increased 58.7% and 28.8%, respectively, since Fall 1990.
- ♦ Enrollment of adult students (i.e., students age 23 and over) has increased 7.5% since Fall 1990 (from 7,361 to 7,914).

COLLEGE

- ♦ The colleges of ASNR, A&S, CBA, COE, and HES showed an increase in *undergraduate and graduate enrollment* from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995.
- ♦ Four colleges (ASNR, A&S, HES, and Vet Med) showed *total enrollment* increases from Fall 1990 to Fall 1995.
- ♦ *Undergraduate enrollment* increased in four colleges from Fall 1990 to Fall 1995 (ASNR, A&S, CEAT, and HES).
- ♦ Five colleges (ASNR, A&S, CBA, HES, and Vet Med) showed *graduate enrollment* increases from Fall 1990 to Fall 1995.

ACADEMIC

- ♦ The average ACT composite for all new freshmen has steadily increased from 23.02 in 1990 to 23.75 in Fall 1995.
- ♦ 78.5% of new freshmen reporting an ACT score had a composite of 21 or above; 68.5% had a composite of 22 or above.
- ♦ In Fall 1995, ACT subscore averages are up over Fall 1994 for Natural Science, English, and Mathematics, while the Reading subscore average remained the same.

- ♦ Females have continued to close the gap between male and female ACT average composite scores: from 0.9 in 1990 to 0.5 in 1995.
- ♦ Engineering and Architecture had the highest ACT composite average of new freshmen with 27.22. They also had the highest average cumulative GPA at the undergraduate level (2.95).
- ♦ The Fall 1995 average composite ACT score for new freshmen increased from Fall 1994 for ASNR, A&S, Engineering & Architecture, and the Division of Technology.
- ♦ The average high school GPA for new freshmen continues to climb: 1995 average high school GPAs are up 5.5% over 1990 and up 11.7% over 1987.
- ♦ 66.5% of new freshmen reporting their high school rank were in the top 30% of their class; 87.2% were in the top half.
- ♦ College of Education graduate students maintained the highest average cumulative GPA at 3.74.
- ♦ Among the races, nonresident alien students had the highest average cumulative undergraduate GPA (2.86). At the graduate level, Hispanics had the highest (3.73).
- ♦ Applications to OSU increased 9% from Fall 1994 to Fall 1995 and approximately the same percentage were accepted (88.6% in 1994, 88.5% in 1995).
- ♦ The percentage of accepted students who actually enrolled increased from 56.9% in Fall 1994 to 58.9% in Fall 1995.

DEGREES

- ♦ In the granting of Bachelor's degrees, the College of Education is the only college that awarded as many or more degrees in 1994-95 as in 1993-94 (426 degrees both academic years).
- ♦ The most Bachelor's degrees were awarded in Curriculum & Instruction.
- ♦ In the awarding of Master's degrees, three colleges awarded more in 1994-95 than in 1993-94: CBA (25.0% increase); CEAT (10.7% increase); and HES (8.7% increase).
- ♦ In the granting of Doctoral degrees, the university awarded 156 in 1994-95 compared with 206 in 1993-94.
- ♦ Females are being awarded a greater number of degrees. In 1994-95, females earned 46.2% of all Bachelor's degrees, compared with 40.0% in 1984-85.
- ♦ The percentage of Doctoral degrees granted to females increased from 28.2% in 1984-85 to 40.3% in 1994-95.

















RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY

















FALL SEMESTERS 1984 THROUGH 1995**



FALL SEMESTERS 1984 THROUGH 1995**




**ENROLLMENT CHANGE OVER THE PAST TWELVE YEARS (1984-1995)








**COMPARISON OF DISTRIBUTION OF NEW FRESHMEN BY HIGH SCHOOL GRADE POINT AVERAGE





FALL SEMESTER 1995





FALL SEMESTER 1995**






AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COLLEGE









OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

The first full year of a new administration at Oklahoma State University yielded the first increase in student body size in the last 13 years, despite a 7% tuition increase. The number of new freshmen on campus improved by nearly 300, and graduate student enrollment rebounded after dropping for two straight years. The projections in this section are mathematical models based on these and other past performances. No attempt has been made to capture any of the "intangibles" which might attract students to the campus. In the past, the new student category has been the best source for increased enrollment. Sources for new students on campus include new freshmen, new graduate students, new transfer students, and readmitted students. This fall, OSU had 2,471 new freshmen (1 enrolled via Educational TV), 1,160 new graduate students, 1,704 new undergraduate transfers, and 596 readmitted undergraduate students.

The new freshman enrollment for Fall 1995 is composed of 84.6% Oklahoma residents and 15.4% non-Oklahoma residents (including international students). Since the percentage of new freshmen who are Oklahoma residents has historically been above 85%, the number of out-of-state new freshmen will be closely monitored for shifts in attendance patterns. For example, the number of nonresident new freshmen rose by over 30% from Fall 1994. However, forecasts of the number of Oklahoma high school graduates are still an important factor for projecting OSU new freshmen enrollment.

The forecasts of Oklahoma high school graduates used in this section are based upon information from the Oklahoma State Department of Education. It assumes that demographic trends such as immigration into and emigration out of the state will remain relatively constant.

In summary, several factors complicate enrollment projections at OSU. Some of these factors depend on policy decisions originating with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and some depend on recruitment policies set by OSU administration. The impact of any new initiatives as well as changing admissions, enrollment, retention, scholarship, and recruiting policies will require the passage of some time in order for their effect to be reflected in the data used as a basis for enrollment projections. As the impact of these policies becomes clear, a new enrollment forecasting model will be developed.





GLOSSARY

Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 1995. Therefore, students born in January 1972 and December 1972 will both be reported as age 23 (1995-1972).

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources (ASNR); Arts and Sciences (A&S); Business Administration (CBA); Education (COE); Engineering, Architecture, and Technology (CEAT); and Human Environmental Sciences (HES). Data for CEAT are sometimes divided into two data sets--one for Engineering & Architecture (ENGR), and the second for the Division of Technology (TECH).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, students may enroll in the University Academic Services, the Graduate College, and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Educational TV Students

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa. A student who is enrolled in courses at OSU and who is also enrolled in an Educational TV course is counted as an OSU student (see Student Location).

Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU excluding nonresident aliens (non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

- White: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe (except Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia, and Iran.
- Black: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa south of the Sahara.
- Native American: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North or South America.
- Hispanic: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Spain or Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spaniards, and Portuguese.
- Asian: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian subcontinent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (including nonresident aliens), some tables and figures which present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the nonresident alien population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a nonresident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as a nonresident alien.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a non-degree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a non-degree seeking student admitted to the Graduate College.

Student Location

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File was defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5, and 6 above).

Type of Admission

A new student admitted to OSU is classified as a new freshman, a transfer student, or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).
