

#### FALL 1997 OSU STUDENT PROFILE DATA AND TREND HIGHLIGHTS

#### **GENERAL**

- First-year retention figures for full-time new freshmen (79.5%) and new transfers (73.8%) are up for the Fall 1996 class, the highest ever recorded in both groups.
- The percentage of the 1991 beginning freshman class graduating after 6 years increased from 47.6% to 49.4% over the 1987 beginning freshman class.
- Stillwater campus enrollment is up for the third year in a row; we are at 80% of our high point that was reached in 1982.
- While OSU's Fall 1997 total enrollment increased by 0.3% from Fall 1996, the state system enrollment decreased by 0.5%.
- Five-year enrollment trends from Fall 1992 to Fall 1997: new freshmen are up 6.7% and graduate enrollment is up 1.2%.
- Counting all students (undergraduate and graduate), once again, all 77 counties in Oklahoma, all 50 states, and 111 foreign countries are represented among OSU's student body.
- ◆ The number of Oklahoma high school graduates is climbing. Both high school graduates and ACT test-takers increased by over 5% between 1996 and 1997. However, OSU's market share of new freshmen decreased between 1996 and 1997, from 6.1% to 5.6% of Oklahoma high school graduates and from 9.0% to 8.3% of Oklahoma ACT test-takers.
- OSU's percentage share of the total state system headcount enrollment in Oklahoma's institutions of higher education increased for the third year in a row, from 11.9% in 1996 to 12.1% in 1997.
- ◆ The number of Oklahoma high school graduates is expected to increase every year between 1997 and 2000. Based on a three-year average market share, OSU should expect an extra 103 new resident freshmen in Fall 1998, an extra 90 new resident freshmen in Fall 1999, and an extra 45 new resident freshmen in Fall 2000 (see page 104).

#### STUDENT BODY

#### **Source of Students**

- Total resident new freshmen increased 3.9% from Fall 1992 to Fall 1997.
- ♦ Total resident new transfers increased 3.9% from Fall 1996 to Fall 1997.
- In Fall 1997, Stillwater High School again provided twice as many new freshmen as the next highest feeder school (121 students). Edmond Memorial High School was the second highest feeder school this year and in 1994, 1993, and 1992 (55, 79, 73, 108 students, respectively). In 1996 and 1995, Jenks High School was the second highest feeder school (60 students both years).

- OSU continues to draw out-of-state new freshmen heavily from the six surrounding states. In Fall 1997, OSU had 209 students from these six states. This number was 8.8% of all new freshmen and 55% of all out-of-state new freshmen.
- Out-of-state undergraduates increased 7.7% from Fall 1996 to Fall 1997 and that reflects continued growth in the proportion of out-of-state undergraduate students.

#### **Composition of Student Body**

- The percentage of minority students has risen for nine straight years, increasing to 22.8% of the student body this fall.
- ♦ Native Americans comprise 7.3% of OSU undergraduates and 6.4% of the entire student body. They also received 5.4% of the degrees granted in the 1996-97 academic year.
- The ethnic makeup of OSU's total enrollment from Fall 1996 to Fall 1997:
  - a significant increase in the number of African-American and Asian students (8.7% and 4.5%, respectively)
  - ♦ International and Hispanic students increased slightly (2.5% and 1.7%, respectively)
  - ♦ Native American and White students showed a slight decrease (-1.1% and -0.3%, respectively).
- The ethnic makeup of OSU's total enrollment from Fall 1992 to Fall 1997:
  - a significant increase in the number of Hispanic (33%), Native American (28%), International (22%), and Asian (11%) students
  - ♦ African-American students showed a slight increase (1%)
  - White students showed a slight decrease (-5%).
- Between Fall 1992 and Fall 1997, out-of-state enrollment increased almost 40%. Enrollment of international students went up 21.7% during the same time period, while in-state enrollments decreased by 6.6%.
- International student enrollment has stayed at or above 10% for four years in a row.
- The percentage of female enrollment increased from 45.6% to 46.5% from Fall 1996 to Fall 1997.
- Enrollment of adult students (i.e., students age 23 and over) has decreased 0.6% since Fall 1996 (from 7,477 to 7,432).
- OSU students borrowed 89% more money in the 1996-97 academic year than they did 5 years previously, while grants and other forms of nondebt financial aid increased only 18%.

#### COLLEGE

- College enrollment trends from Fall 1996 to Fall 1997:
  - No college showed an increase in both undergraduate and graduate enrollment.
  - ♦ Four colleges (ASNR, CBA, HES, and Vet Med) showed total enrollment increases.
  - ♦ Two colleges (CBA and HES) showed undergraduate enrollment increases.
  - ♦ Three colleges (ASNR, A&S, and Vet Med) showed graduate enrollment increases.
- College enrollment trends from Fall 1992 to Fall 1997:
  - ♦ Three colleges (ASNR, CBA, and HES) showed an increase in **both** undergraduate and graduate enrollment.
  - ♦ Five colleges (ASNR, A&S, CBA, HES, and Vet Med) showed total enrollment increases.
  - ♦ Four colleges (ASNR, A&S, CBA, and HES) showed undergraduate enrollment increases.
  - ♦ Five colleges (ASNR, CBA, COE, HES, and Vet Med) showed *graduate enrollment* increases.

#### **ACADEMIC**

- The average ACT composite for all new freshmen increased from 23.9 in 1996 to 24.3 in Fall 1997.
- In Fall 1997, **all** ACT subscore averages are up over Fall 1996: Natural Science (from 23.8 to 24.1), English (from 23.6 to 23.9), Mathematics (from 22.6 to 23.4), and Reading (from 24.9 to 25.3).
- ◆ The Fall 1997 average composite ACT score for new freshmen increased from Fall 1996 for all colleges but one.
- 18% of new freshmen reporting their high school rank were in the top 5% of their class; 60% were in the top 25%.
- The average high school GPA for new freshmen continues to climb: the 1997 average high school GPA is now 3.51, with 58.2% of new freshmen reporting a high school GPA of 3.6 or above.
- Engineering and Architecture students continue to have the highest overall cumulative GPA (3.00) and the highest composite ACT scores for new freshmen (27.00) of all OSU colleges. College of Education graduate students maintained the highest average cumulative GPA at 3.76.
- This year's alternative admissions class has an average high school GPA of 3.07, an average high school percentile rank of 46%, and an average ACT composite score of 19.4. Five years ago, our alternative admissions class had an average high school GPA of 2.8, an average high school percentile of 46%, and an average ACT composite score of 19.2.

#### **DEGREES**

- ◆ In the granting of Bachelor's degrees, three colleges awarded more degrees in 1996-97 as in 1995-96: ASNR (8.8% increase), CBA (11.3% increase), and HES (6.5% increase).
- Curriculum & Instruction, Management, Marketing, and Finance have all been among the top 10 Bachelors degree-granting departments for the past 10 years.
- Dean of Business Administration, Applied Behavioral Studies, Curriculum & Instruction, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, and Occupational & Adult Education have all been among the top 10 graduate degree-granting departments for the past 10 years.
- In the awarding of Master's degrees, all colleges except CEAT awarded more in 1996-97 than in 1995-96.
- In the granting of Doctoral degrees, three colleges awarded more in 1996-97 than in 1995-96: A&S (38.6% increase), COE (13.2% increase), and CEAT (7.7% increase).
- Compared to 1995-96, the percentage of degrees granted to women in 1996-97:
  - ♦ Bachelor's degrees increased slightly (from 46.7% to 47.1%)
  - ♦ Masters degrees increased slightly (from 40% to 40.7%)
  - ♦ Doctoral degrees increased slightly (from 39.4% to 40.7%)
  - ♦ All degrees increased slightly (from 45% to 45.5%)
- ♦ Compared to 1987-88, the percentage of degrees granted to women in 1996-97:
  - ♦ Bachelor's degrees increased (from 40.9% to 47.1%)
  - ♦ Masters degrees increased slightly (from 40% to 40.7%)
  - ♦ Doctoral degrees increased (from 34.8% to 40.7%)
  - ♦ All degrees increased (from 40.5% to 45.5%)
- International students received 15% of all degrees granted in 1995-96, while Native Americans received 5%, Asians received 2%, African Americans received 2%, and Hispanics received 1%. These percentages showed little change from the 1994-95 academic year.








## SOURCE OF NEW FRESHMEN BY RESIDENT STATUS OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY FALL 1997







#### RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY



















#### OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY FALL SEMESTERS 1986 THROUGH 1997




## FALL SEMESTERS 1986 THROUGH 1997 (Expressed in Percentages)






























### OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT AND PROJECTIONS

Enrollment at Oklahoma State University increased in Fall 1997 over the previous year by 149 students. Undergraduate retention rates have improved significantly in the 1990's and will continue to have a large impact on enrollment numbers. For example, this fall's sophomore class (Fall 1996 freshmen) is larger than last fall's sophomore class (Fall 1995 freshmen) even though the latter was the bigger freshman class. This fall, OSU has 10,189 returning undergraduates in addition to 2,377 new freshmen, 857 new graduate students, 1,527 new undergraduate transfers, and 638 readmitted undergraduate students. The projections in this section are mathematical models based on these and other past performances. No attempt has been made to capture any of the "intangibles" which might attract future students to the campus.

The new freshman enrollment for Fall 1997 is composed of 84% Oklahoma residents. This percentage share is characteristic of the freshman classes enrolling in this decade. Forecasts for Oklahoma high school graduates show increasing numbers through the end of the millennium, so the percentage of Oklahoma residents in future freshmen classes should account for an increasing share of each new freshman class. The forecasts of Oklahoma high school graduates used in this section are based upon information from the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the State Regents for Higher Education. It assumes that demographic trends such as immigration into and emigration out of the state will remain relatively constant.

In summary, several factors affect enrollment projections at OSU. Some of these factors depend on policy decisions originating with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and some depend on recruitment policies set by OSU administration. The impact of these policies as well as changing admissions, enrollment, retention, scholarship, and recruiting practices all have a role in determining future enrollment at Oklahoma State University. The Office of Planning, Budget & Institutional Research will continue to monitor developments in these areas and assess their impact on enrollment.





#### **GLOSSARY**

#### Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 1995. Therefore, students born in January 1972 and December 1972 will both be reported as age 24 (1996-1972).

#### Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

#### College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources (ASNR); Arts and Sciences (A&S); Business Administration (CBA); Education (COE); Engineering, Architecture, and Technology (CEAT); and Human Environmental Sciences (HES). Data for CEAT are sometimes divided into two data sets--one for Engineering & Architecture (ENGR), and the second for the Division of Technology (TECH).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, students may enroll in the University Academic Services, the Graduate College, and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

#### **Ethnicity Codes and Definitions**

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by ethnicity, the total enrollment at OSU <u>excluding</u> <u>internationals (non-U.S. citizens)</u> is divided into the following categories:

White: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Europe (except

Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria,

Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia, and Iran.

African American: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa south of the

Sahara.

Native American: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North or South

America.

Hispanic:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Spain or Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos,

Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans,

Puerto Ricans, Spaniards, and Portuguese.

Asian:

All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian subcontinent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (<u>including</u> international students), some tables and figures which present data by ethnicity in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the international student population.

#### **Resident Status**

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a nonresident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as an international.

#### Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

### Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a non-degree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a non-degree seeking student admitted to the Graduate College.

#### **Student Location**

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File was defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

- O Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
- 1 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCT)
- 2 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCT)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled at the University Center at Tulsa (0 and 1 above).

#### Type of Admission

A new student admitted to OSU is classified as a new freshman, a transfer student, or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).
