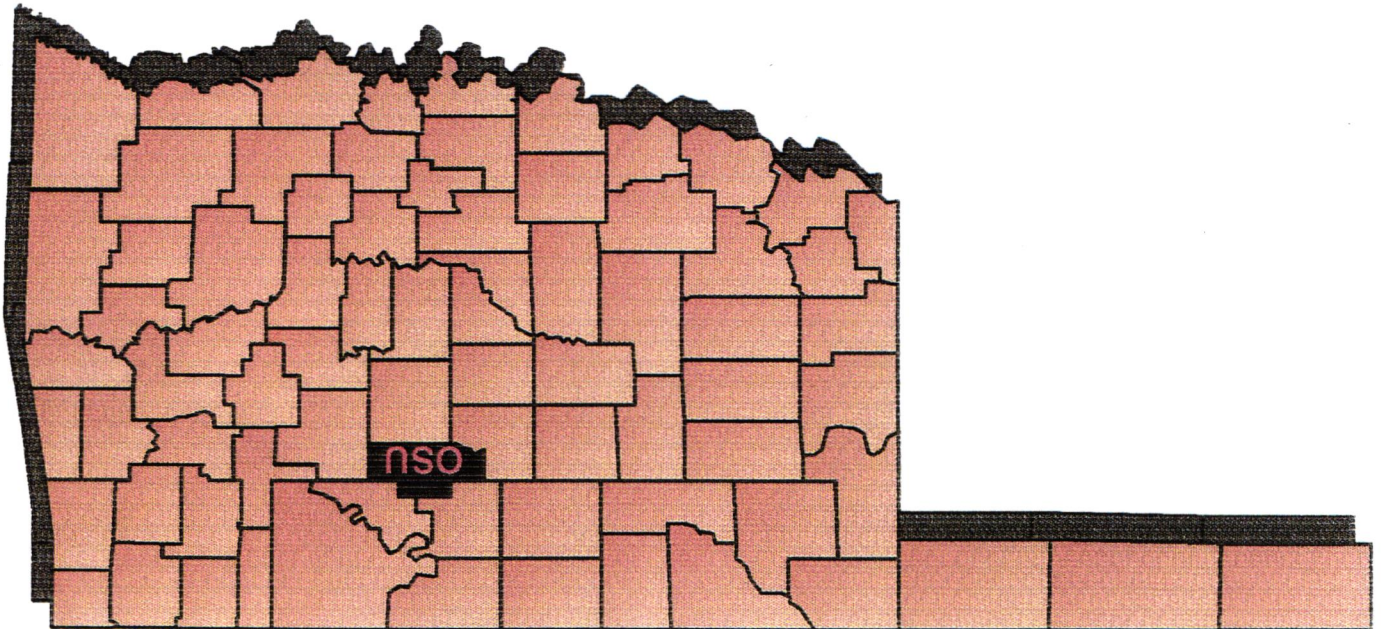

OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY

FALL 1998 OSU STUDENT PROFILE DATA AND TREND HIGHLIGHTS

GENERAL

- ◆ First-year retention figures for full-time new freshmen (82.4%) and new transfers (74.2%) are up for the Fall 1997 class, the highest ever recorded in both groups.
- ◆ The percentage of the 1992 beginning freshman class graduating within 6 years increased from 48.2% to 50.5% over the 1988 beginning freshman class.
- ◆ While OSU's Fall 1998 total enrollment increased by 5.8% from Fall 1997, the state system enrollment increased by 0.7%.
- ◆ Headcount enrollment at OSU went up by 1,116 and is the highest since 1986. FTE enrollment went up by 926 from 1997.
- ◆ Counting all students (undergraduate and graduate), once again, all 77 counties in Oklahoma, all 50 states, and 116 foreign countries are represented among OSU's student body.
- ◆ Oklahoma high school graduates increased by 6% and ACT test-takers increased by almost 5% between 1997 and 1998. OSU's market share of new freshmen increased between 1997 and 1998, to 6.2% of Oklahoma high school graduates and to 8.8% of Oklahoma ACT test-takers.
- ◆ OSU's percentage share of the total state system headcount enrollment in Oklahoma's institutions of higher education increased for the fourth year in a row, from 12.1% in 1997 to 12.7% in 1998.
- ◆ Based on a three-year average of market share of Oklahoma high school graduates, PB&IR predicted an extra 103 resident new freshmen in Fall 1998. OSU actually received an increase of 224 resident new freshmen over 1997.
- ◆ The percentage of undergraduate married students decreased from 8.4% in the Fall 1997 to 7% in the Fall 1998. The average age of undergraduates also decreased from 22.29 in the Fall 1997 to 22.16 in the Fall 1998.
- ◆ OSU student's non-debt related aid increased from 50% in 1996-97 to 54% in 1997-98 of the total aid given.

STUDENT BODY

Source of Students

- ◆ Total *resident new freshmen* increased by 11% from Fall 1997 to Fall 1998.
- ◆ New freshmen enrollment increased by 12% over 1997 and is the largest new freshmen cohort since 1989.
- ◆ In Fall 1998, Stillwater High School again was the highest feeder school with 126 students. Second highest this year is Jenks High School. Putnam City North rose to the third highest feeder school this year while it was 11th in 1997.

- ◆ OSU continues to draw out-of-state new freshmen heavily from the six surrounding states. In Fall 1998, OSU had 256 students from these six states. This number was 9.6% of all new freshmen and 56% of all out-of-state new freshmen.
- ◆ In 1996 we had 4 new freshmen at OSU-Tulsa and none at TAFB, and in 1997 we had no new freshmen at either place. This year 20 new freshmen attend OSU-Tulsa and 11 new freshmen attend TAFB. The average age of the on campus new freshmen is 18.7 years, but the average age of OSU-Tulsa and TAFB new freshmen is 34.5 years.
- ◆ Out-of-state undergraduate enrollment increased from 11.1% in the Fall 1997 to 11.8% in the Fall 1998.
- ◆ The percentage of on campus new transfer students increased from 11.6% in the Fall 1997 to 12.2% in the Fall 1998.
- ◆ OSU-Tulsa enrollment rose by 8.6% from the Fall 1997, with the largest increase in undergraduate students.

Composition of Student Body

- ◆ The percentage of minority students excluding international students is 14.2% of the student body this fall.
- ◆ Native American enrollment increased by 13.5% while OSU's total enrollment increased only by 5.8% between Fall 1997 and Fall 1998.
- ◆ The ethnic makeup of OSU's total enrollment for Fall 1998:
 - ◇ International percentage of the student body decreased slightly from 10% to 9.7%.
 - ◇ Asian, Hispanic, and African-American percentages remained essentially the same.
 - ◇ Native American percentage increased from 7% to 7.4%.
- ◆ The ethnic makeup of OSU's total enrollment from Fall 1993 to Fall 1998:
 - ◇ A significant increase in the number of Hispanic (37%), Native American (34%), International (13%), and African-American (15.5%) students.
 - ◇ White and Asian students showed a slight increase of 4.7% and 1% respectively.
- ◆ Between Fall 1993 and Fall 1998, out-of-state enrollment increased almost 51.2% while in-state enrollment increased by 2.3%.
- ◆ The percentage of female enrollment remained the same as last year at 46.5%.
- ◆ Enrollment of adult undergraduate students (i.e., students age 23 and over) decreased from 27.2% in the Fall 1997 to 26.3% in the Fall 1998.

ACADEMIC

- ♦ The average ACT composite for all new freshmen remained at 24.3 while the Oklahoma ACT composite decreased from 20.6 in the Fall 1997 to 20.5 in the Fall 1998.
- ♦ 17% of new freshmen reporting their high school rank were in the top 5% of their class; 60% were in the top 25%.
- ♦ 62% of new freshmen report a high school GPA of 3.5 or above.
- ♦ Engineering and Architecture undergraduates continue to have the highest overall cumulative GPA (3.02) and the highest composite ACT scores for new freshmen (27.07) of all OSU colleges. College of Education graduate students maintained the highest average cumulative GPA at 3.81.

DEGREES

- ♦ In the granting of Bachelor degrees from 1996-97 to 1997-98, Arts and Sciences increased from 25.3% to 27.1% and Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources increased from 12.4% to 13.4%.
- ♦ In the granting of Graduate degrees from 1996-97 to 1997-98, Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources increased from 10.2% to 12.8%, Human Environmental Sciences increased from 3.9% to 4.4%, Business Administration increased from 16.8% to 17.2%, Interdisciplinary Studies increased from 3.7% to 6.1% while all other colleges decreased.
- ♦ The top five Bachelor degree areas for 1997-98 are Management, Engineering Technology, Animal Science, Marketing, and Curriculum & Instruction.
- ♦ The top five Graduate degree areas for 1997-98 are Dean of Business Administration, Electronic & Computer Engineering, Dean of Education, Graduate College/Interdisciplinary Studies and Management.
- ♦ Compared to 1987-88, the percentage of degrees granted to women in 1997-98:
 - ♦ Bachelor's degrees increased (from 40.9% to 45.8%)
 - ♦ Masters degrees increased slightly (from 40% to 42.6%)
 - ♦ Doctoral degrees decreased slightly (from 36.4% to 35%)
 - ♦ All degrees increased (from 40.5% to 44.6%)
- ♦ International students received 14.9% of all degrees granted in 1997-98, while Native Americans received 4.7%, Asians received 1.8%, African-Americans received 1.8%, and Hispanics received 1.5%.

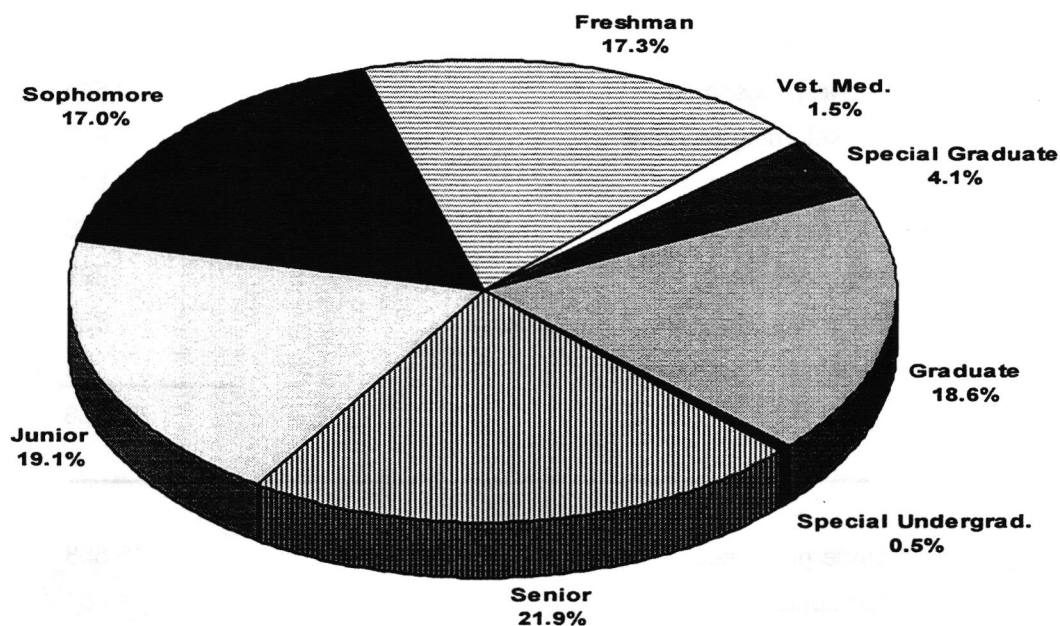

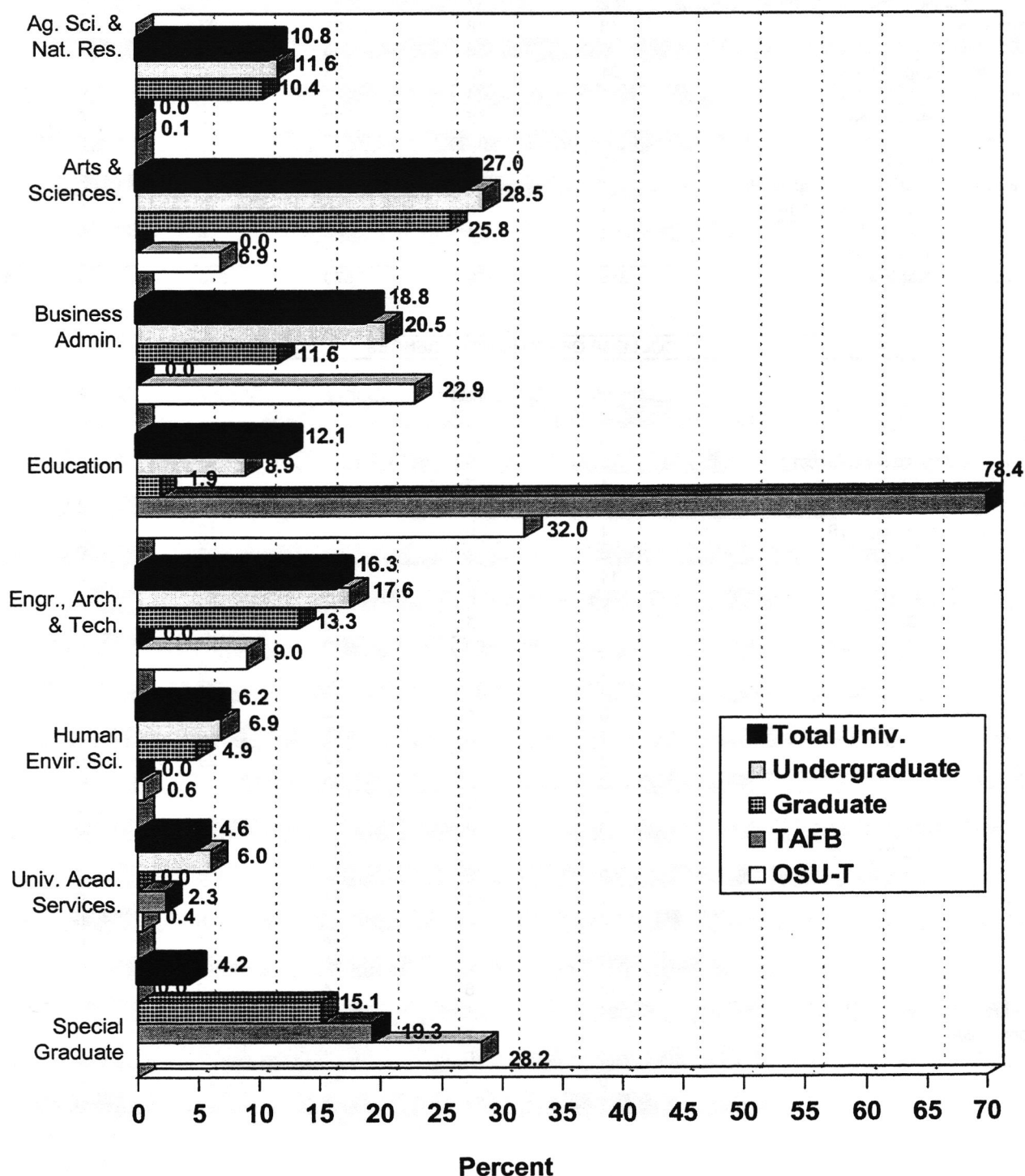

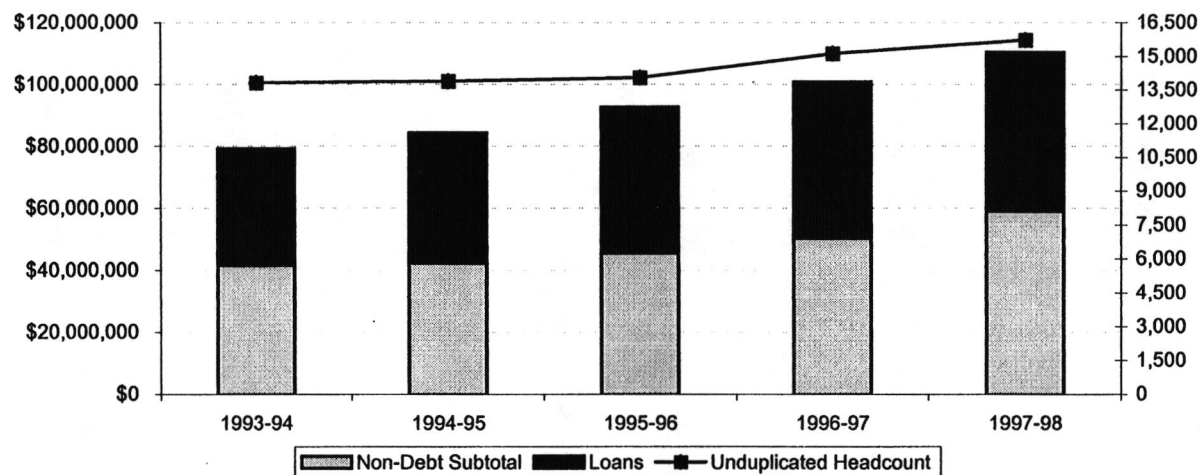

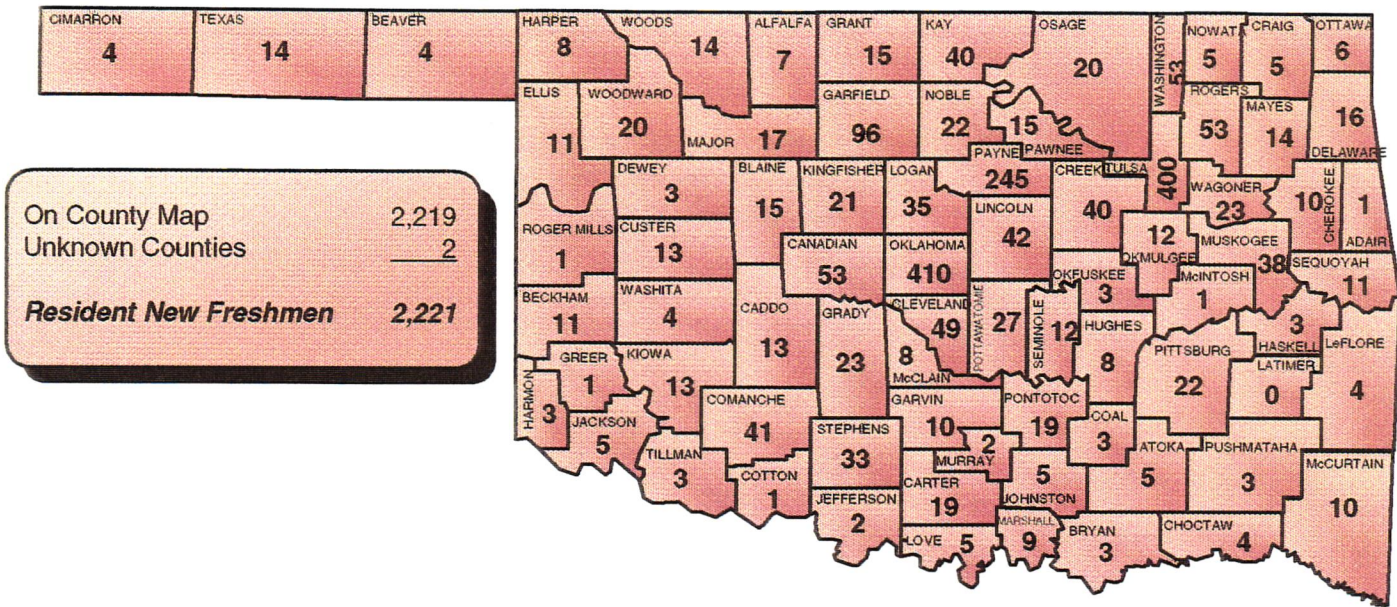

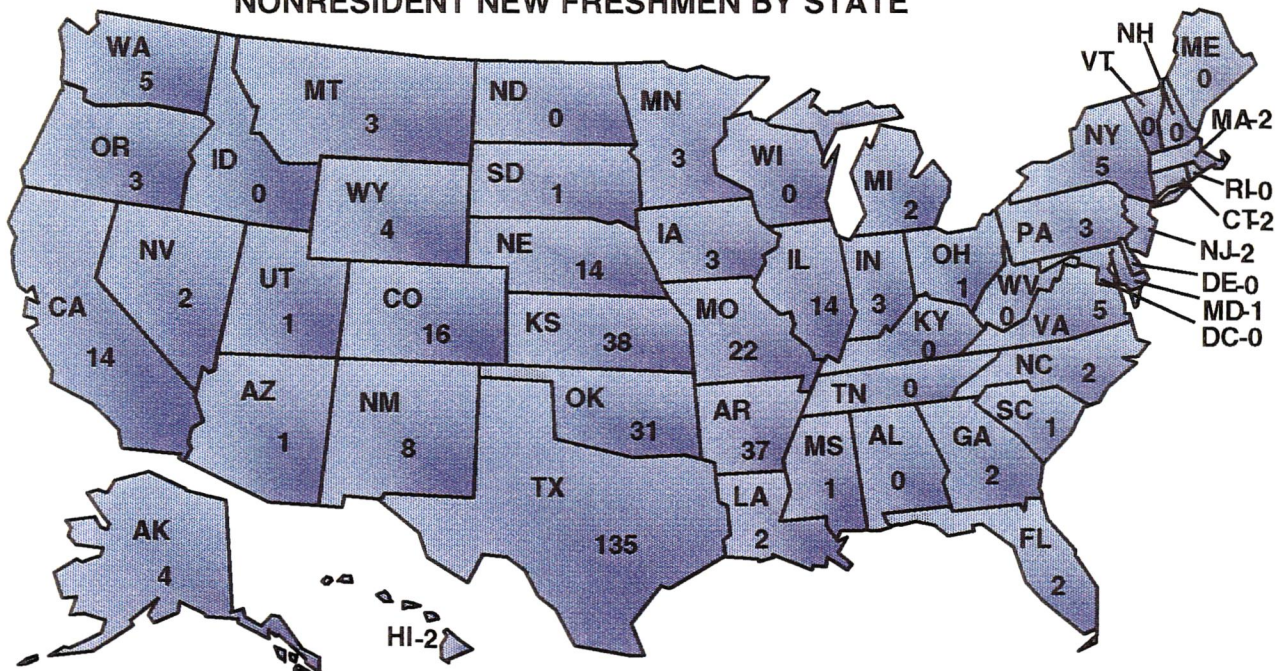

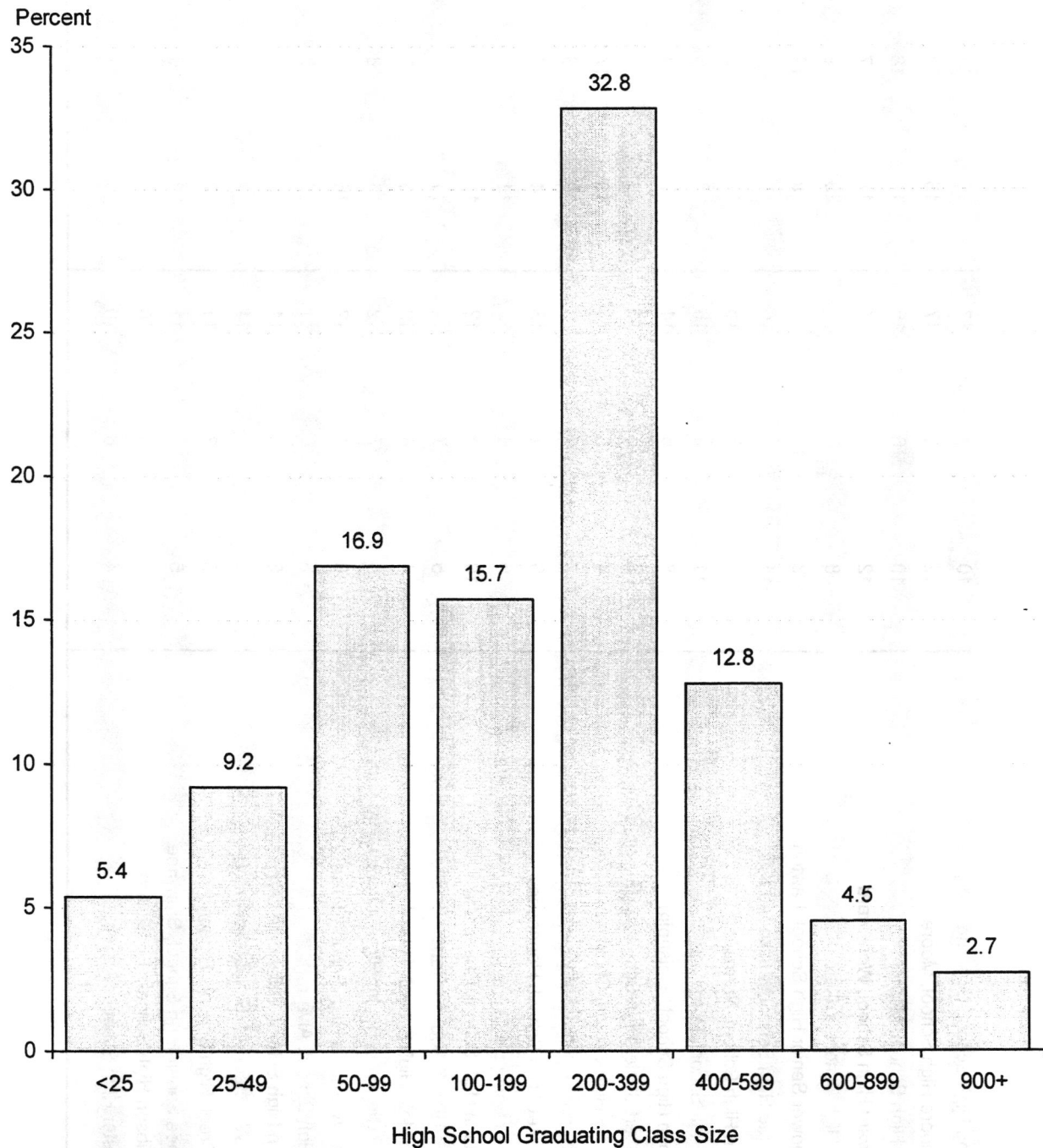

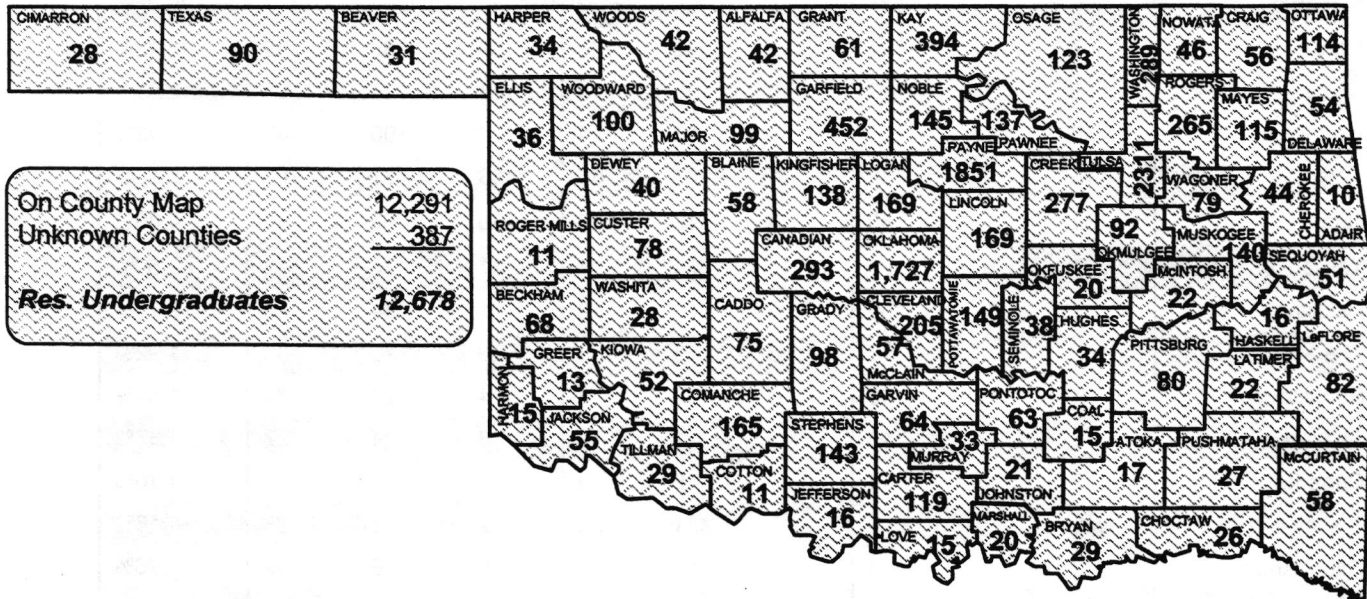

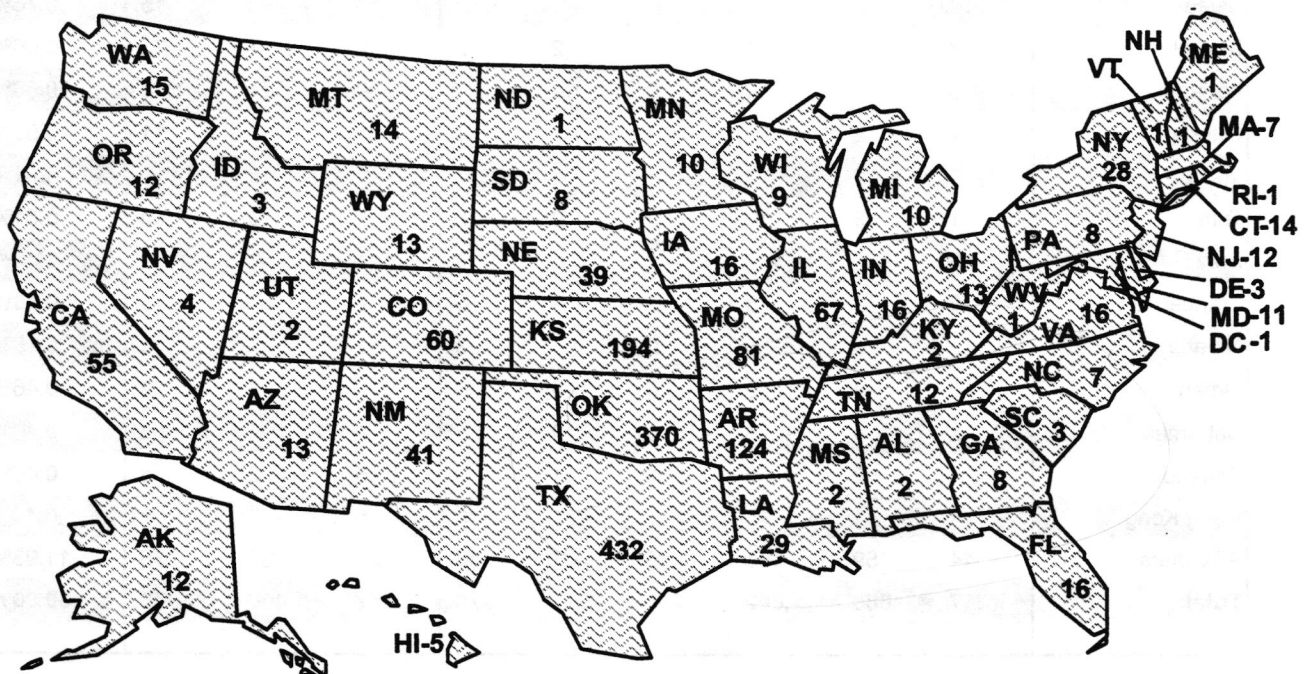

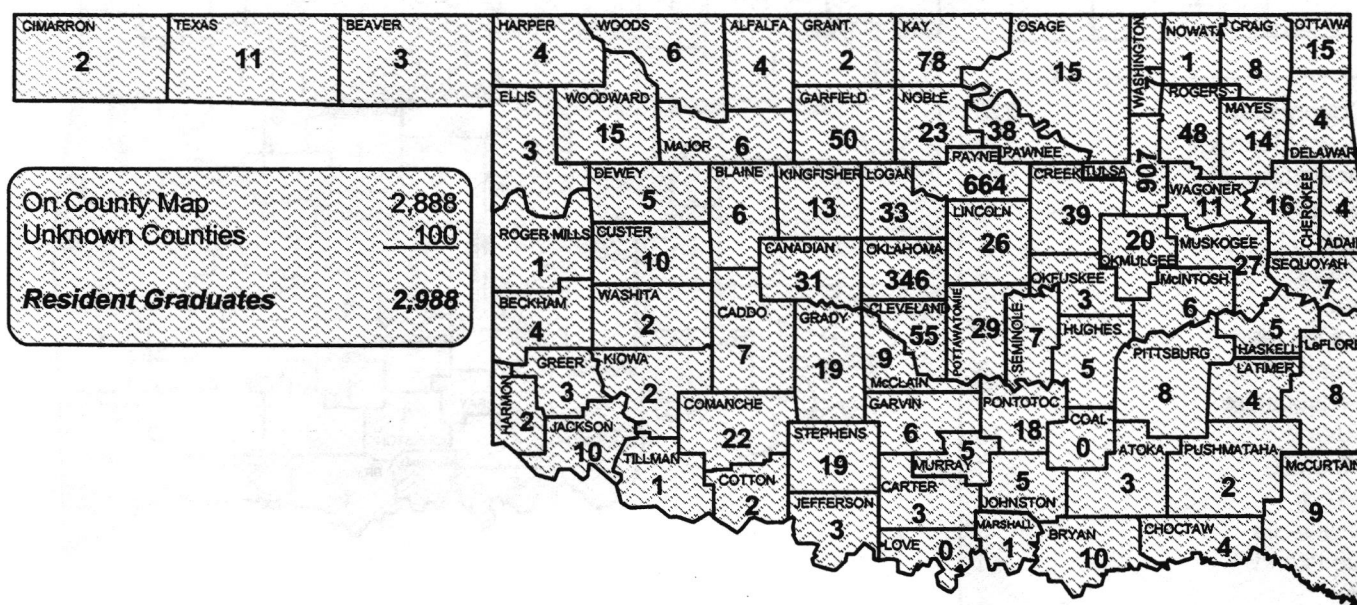

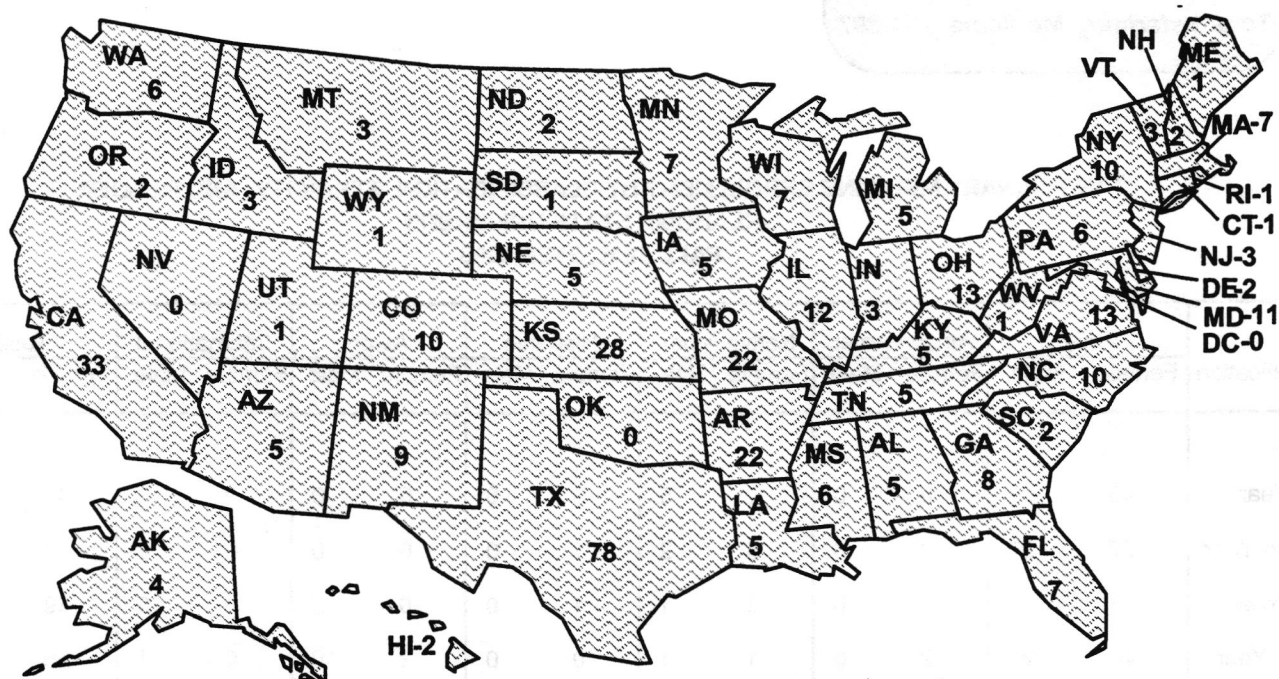

RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY

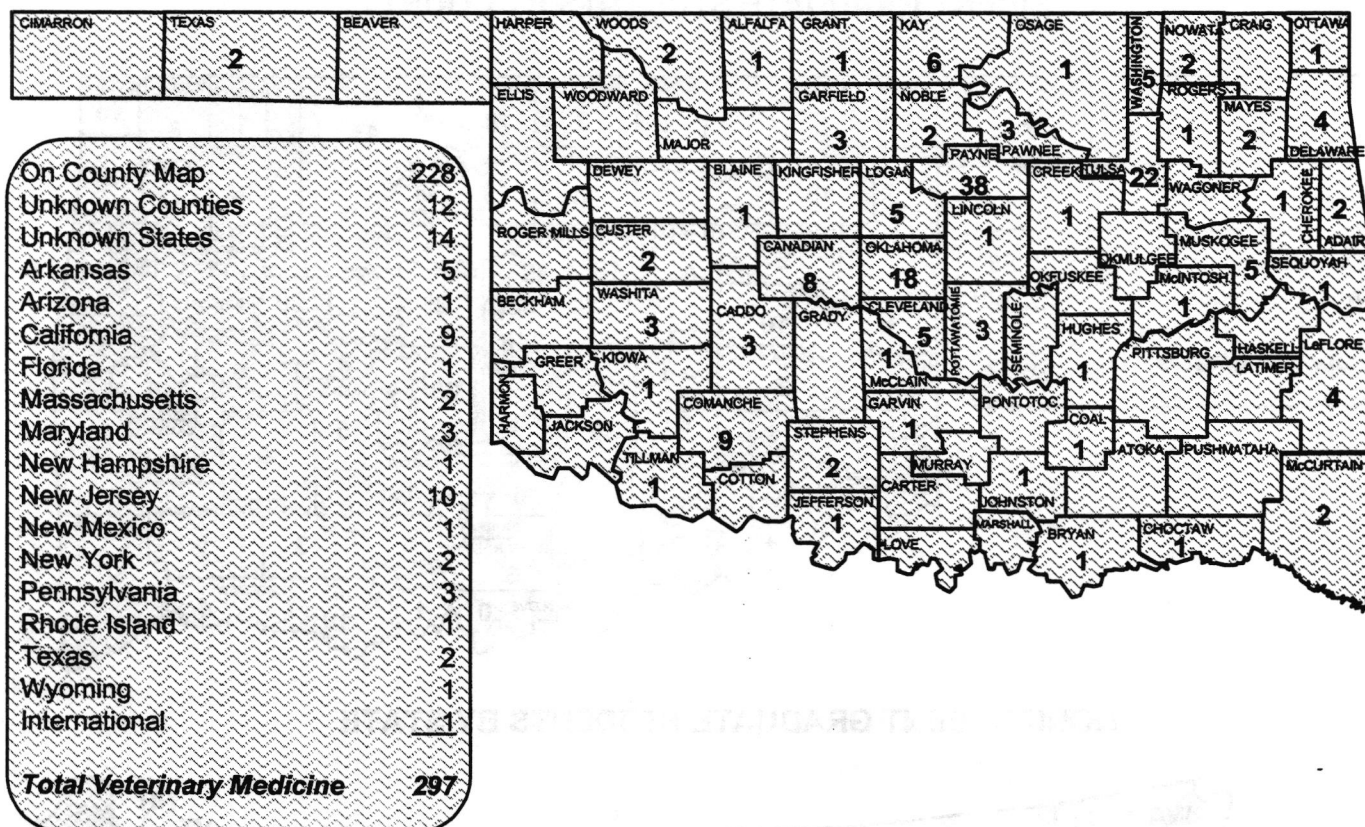


NONRESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE

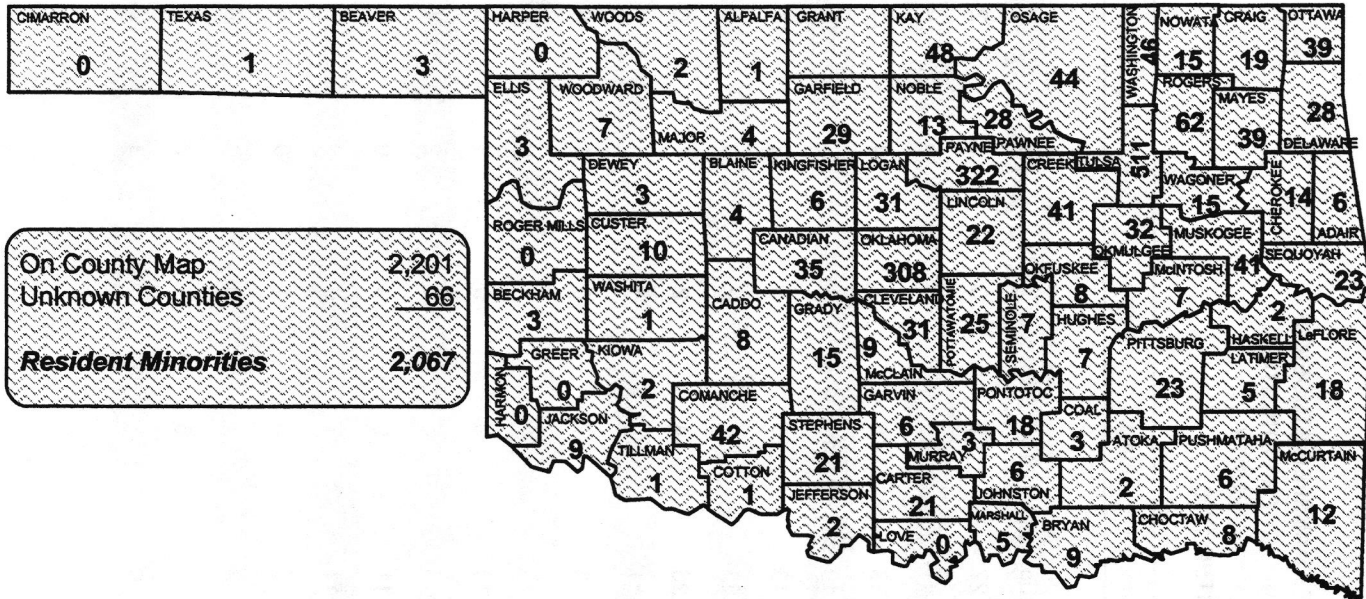

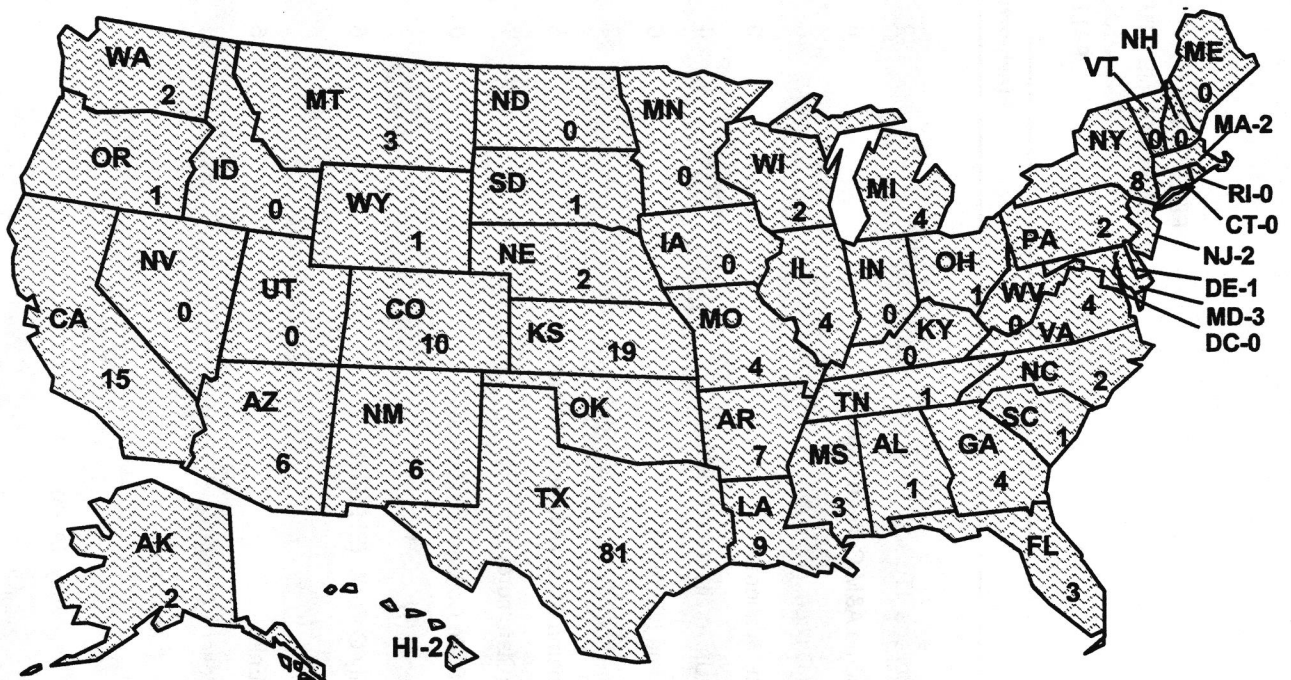

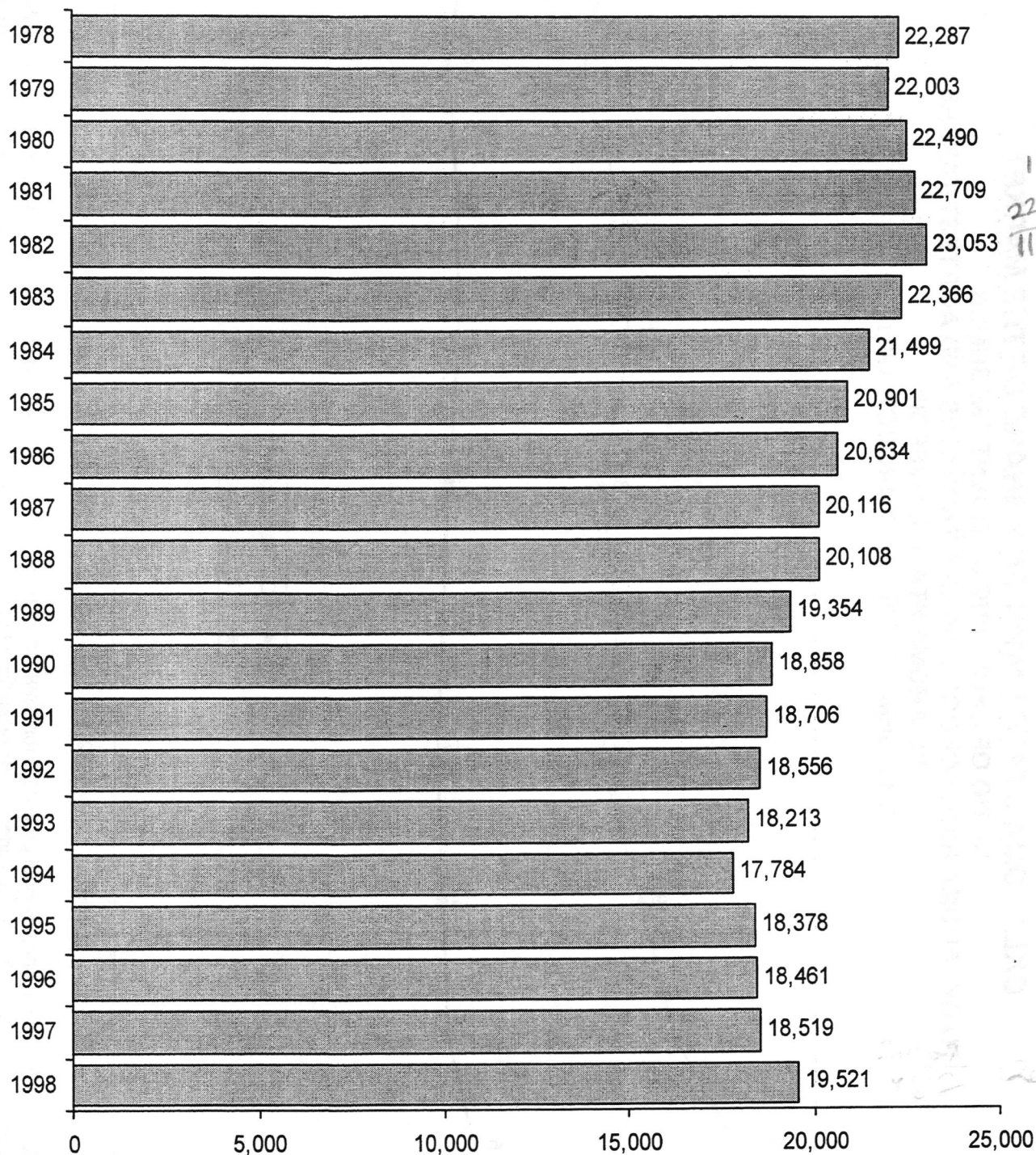

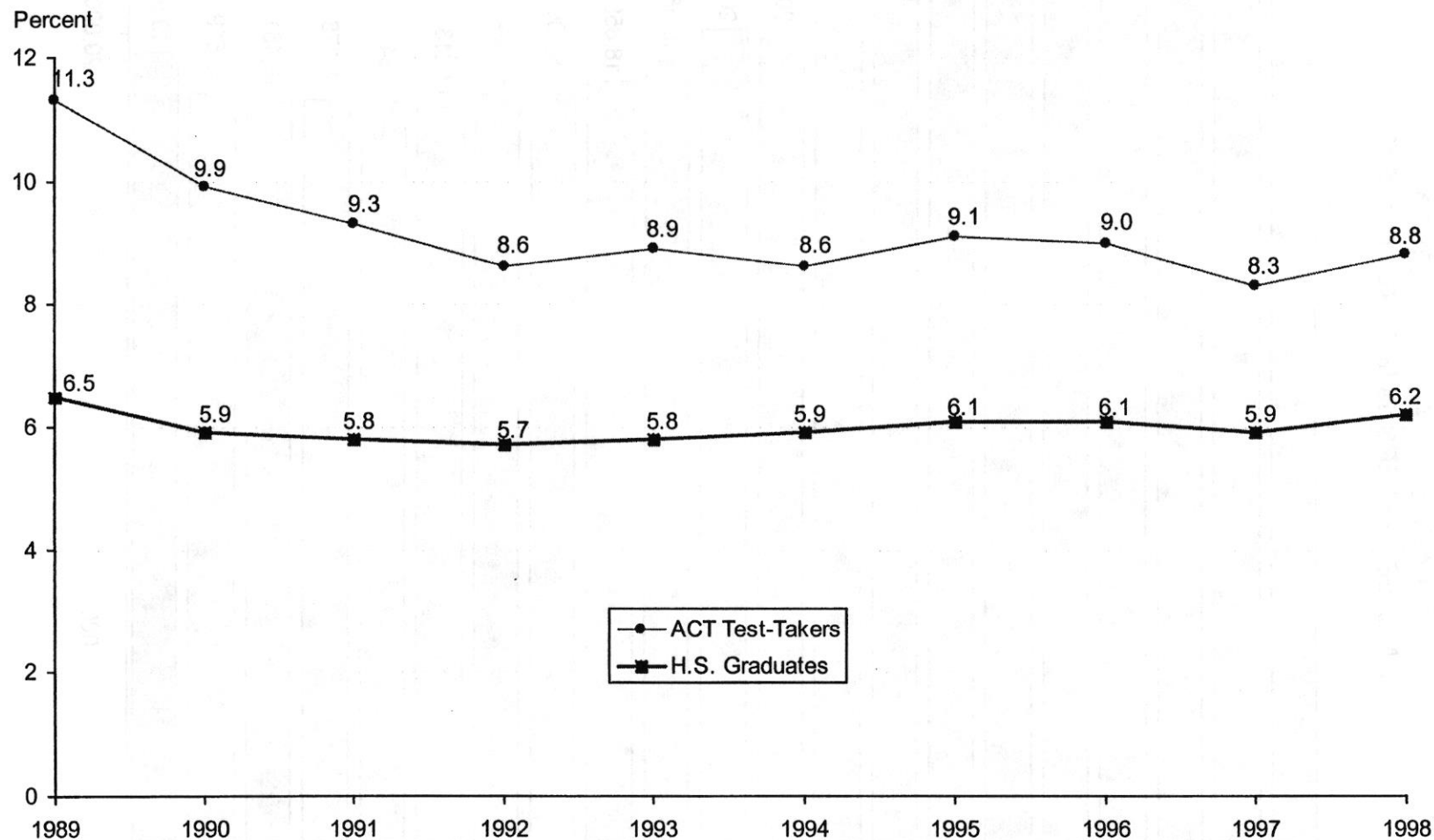

FALL SEMESTERS 1989 THROUGH 1998**



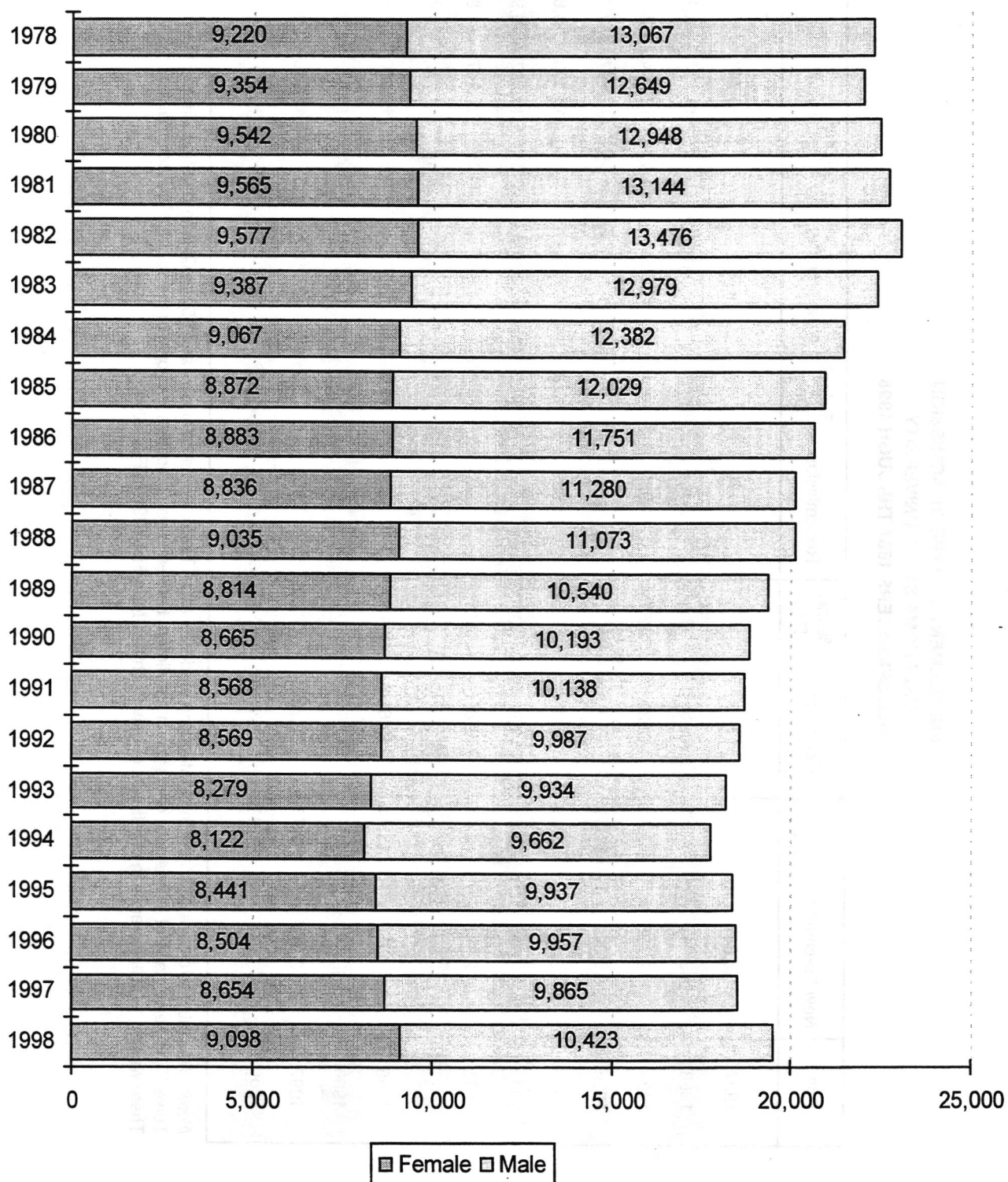

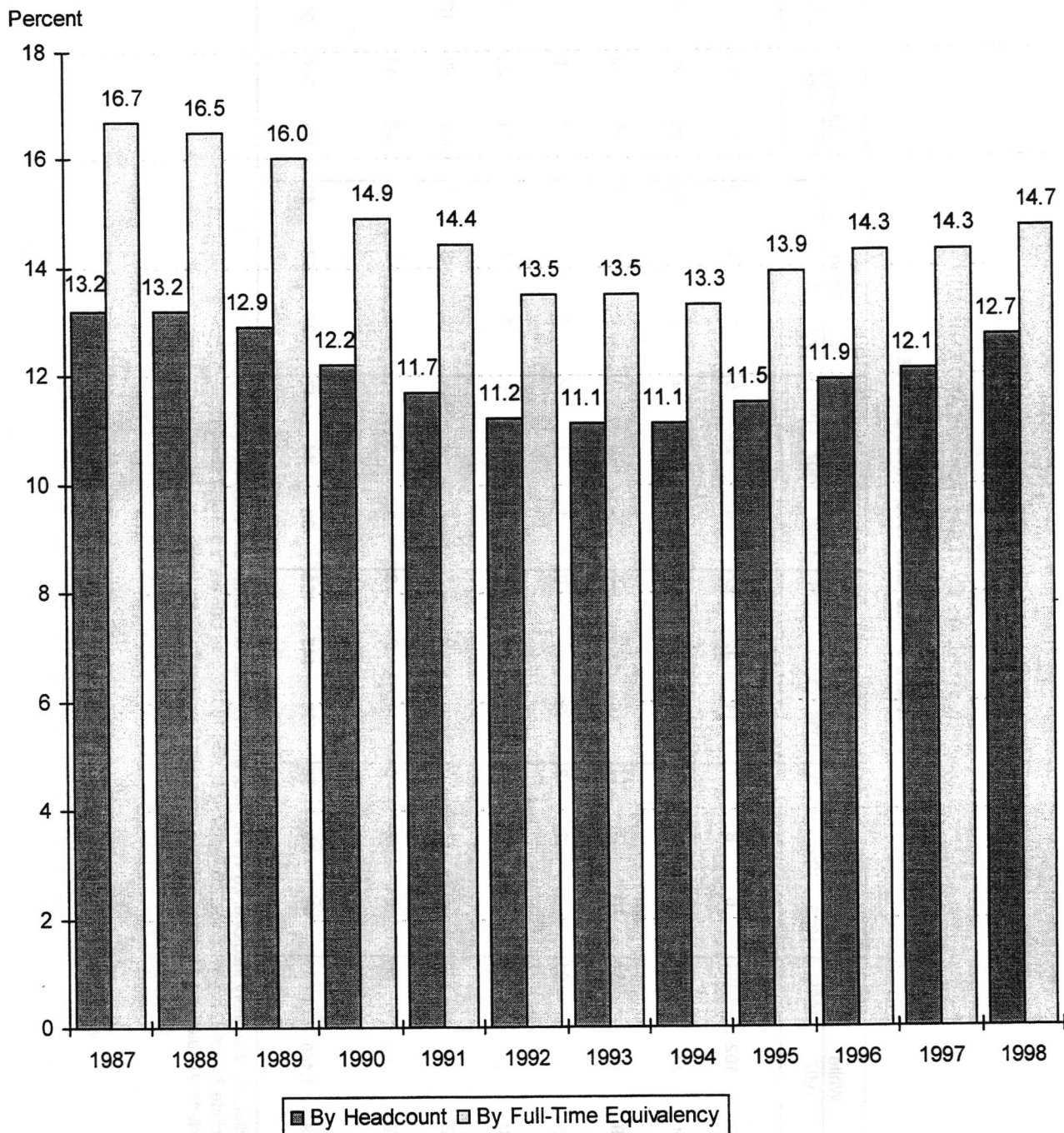

IN THE OKLAHOMA STATE SYSTEMS (PUBLIC)**

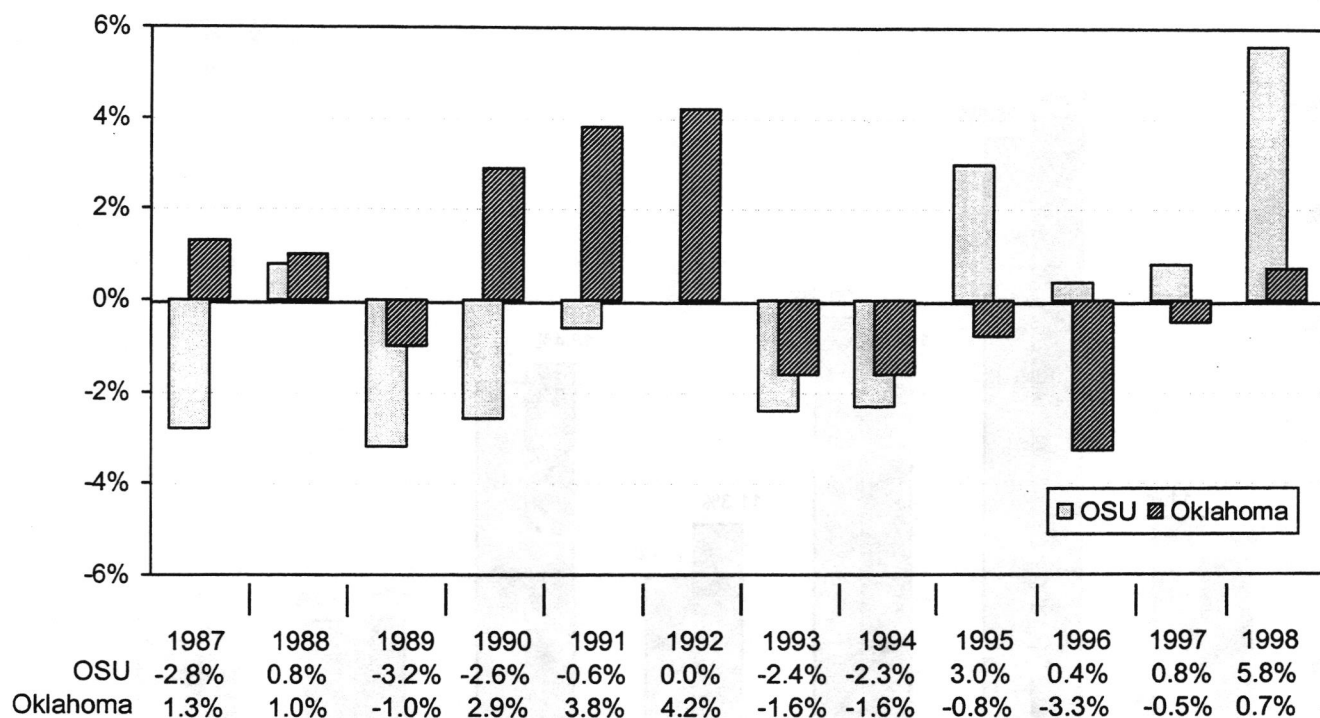

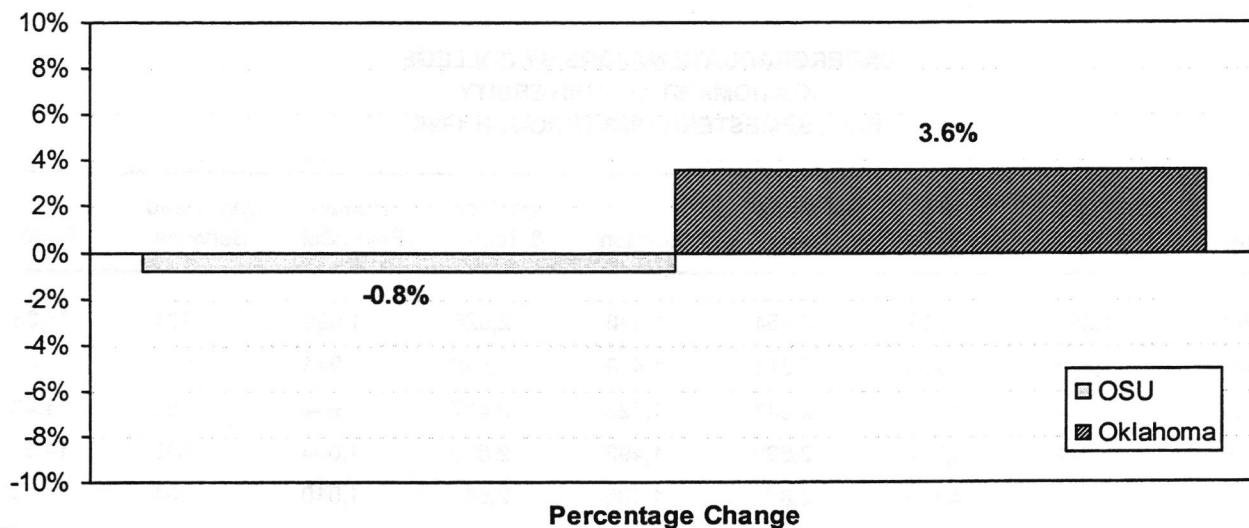

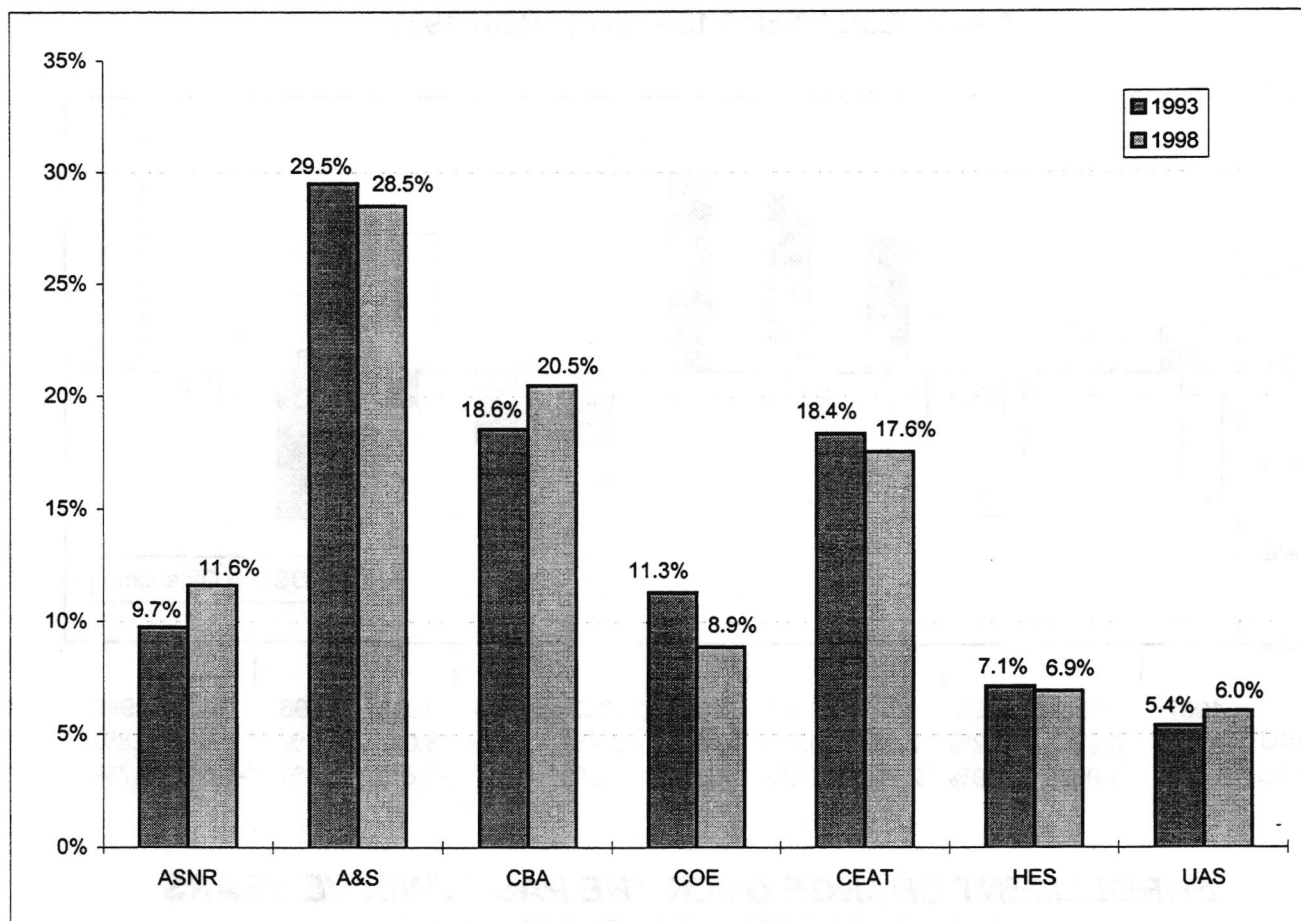
ENROLLMENT CHANGE OVER THE PAST TWELVE YEARS

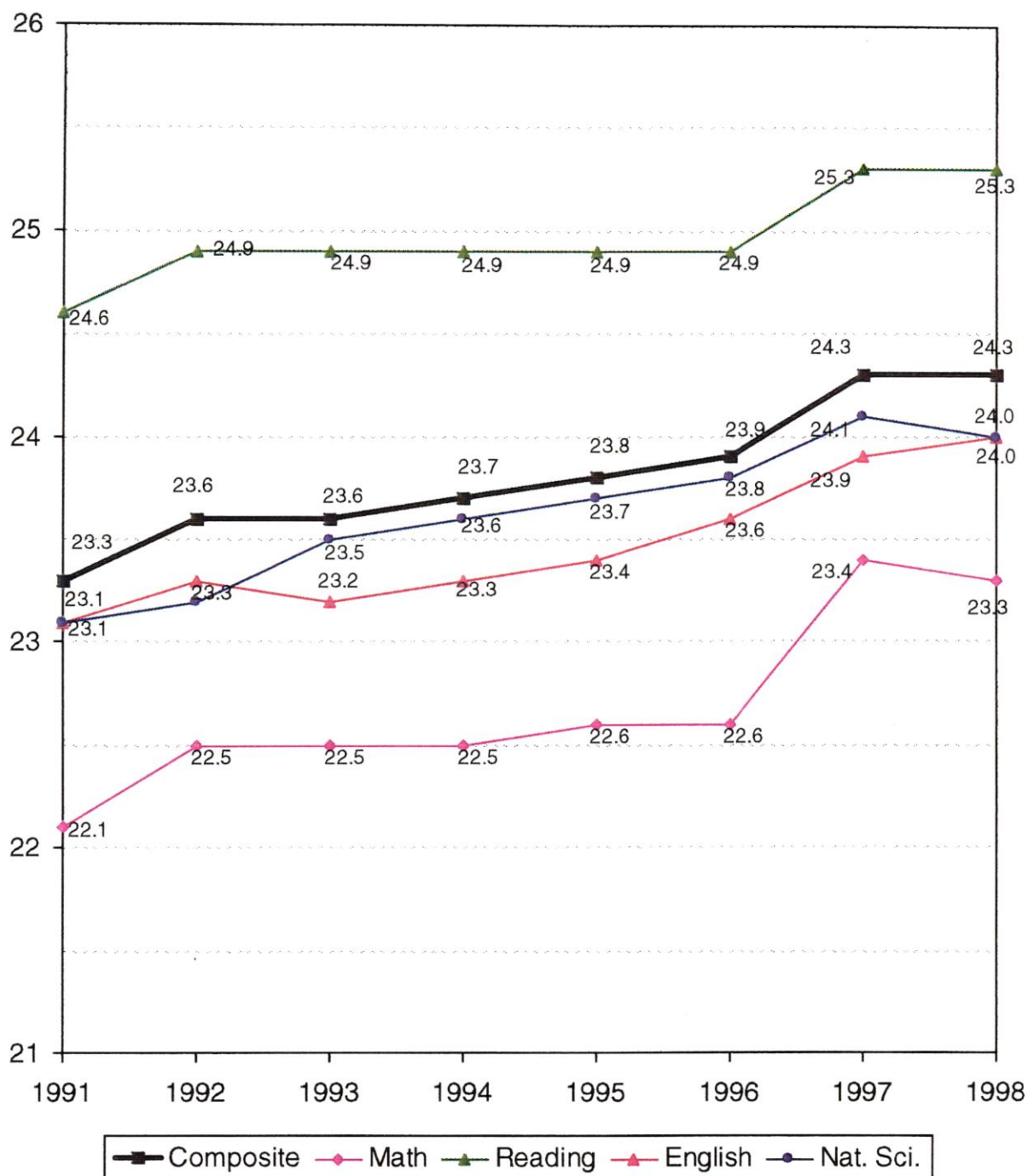

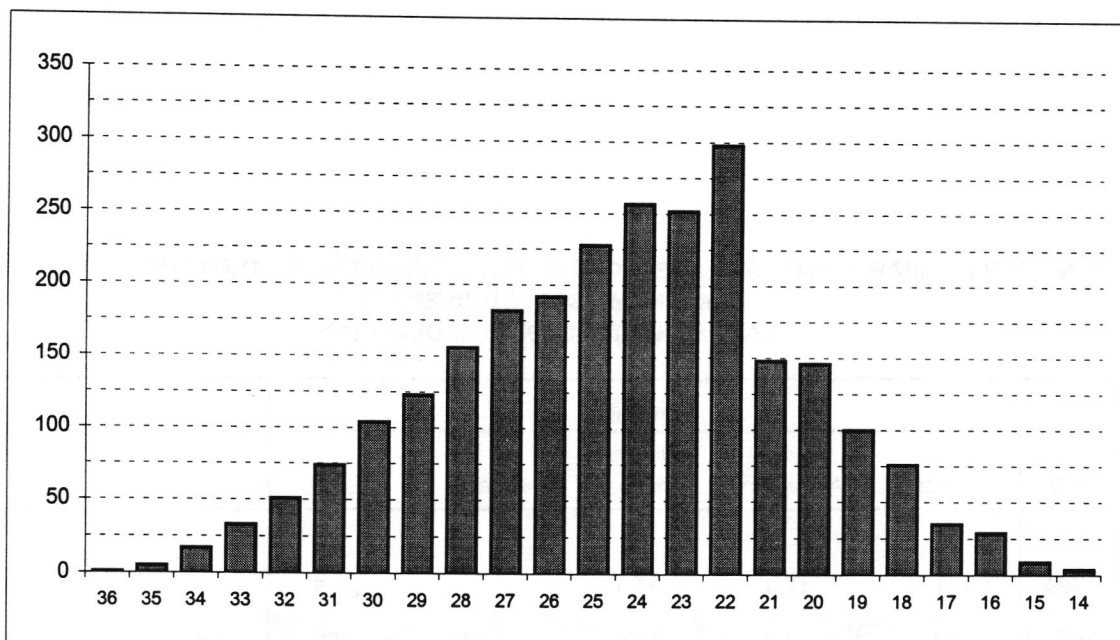

FALL SEMESTER 1998**

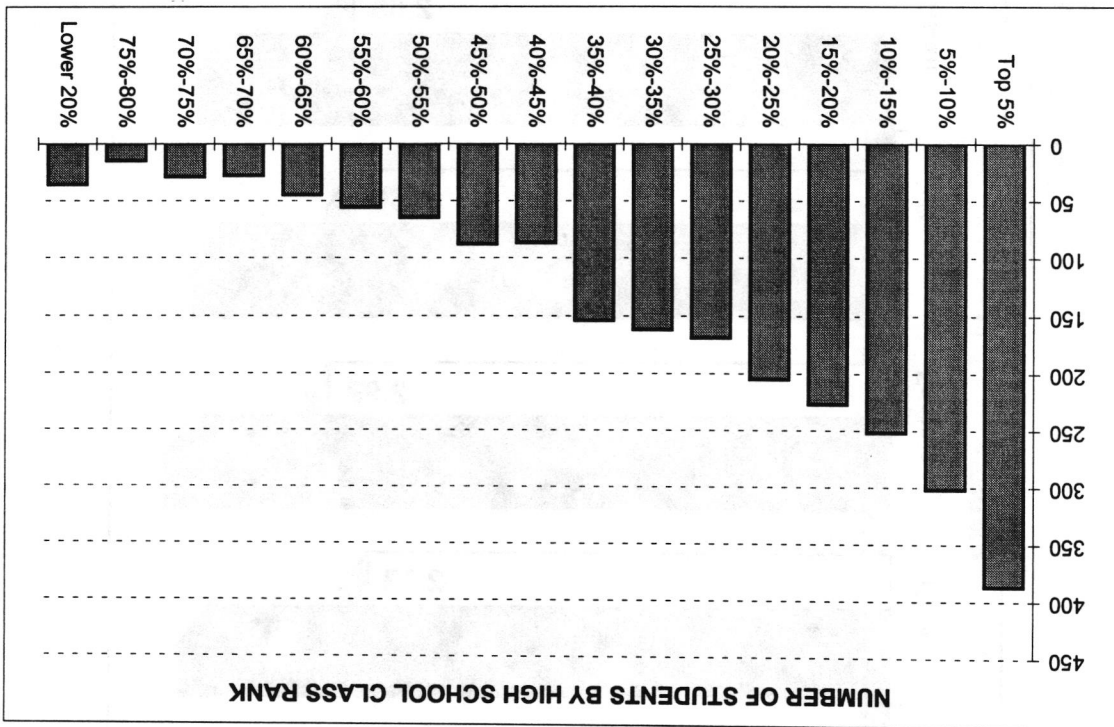

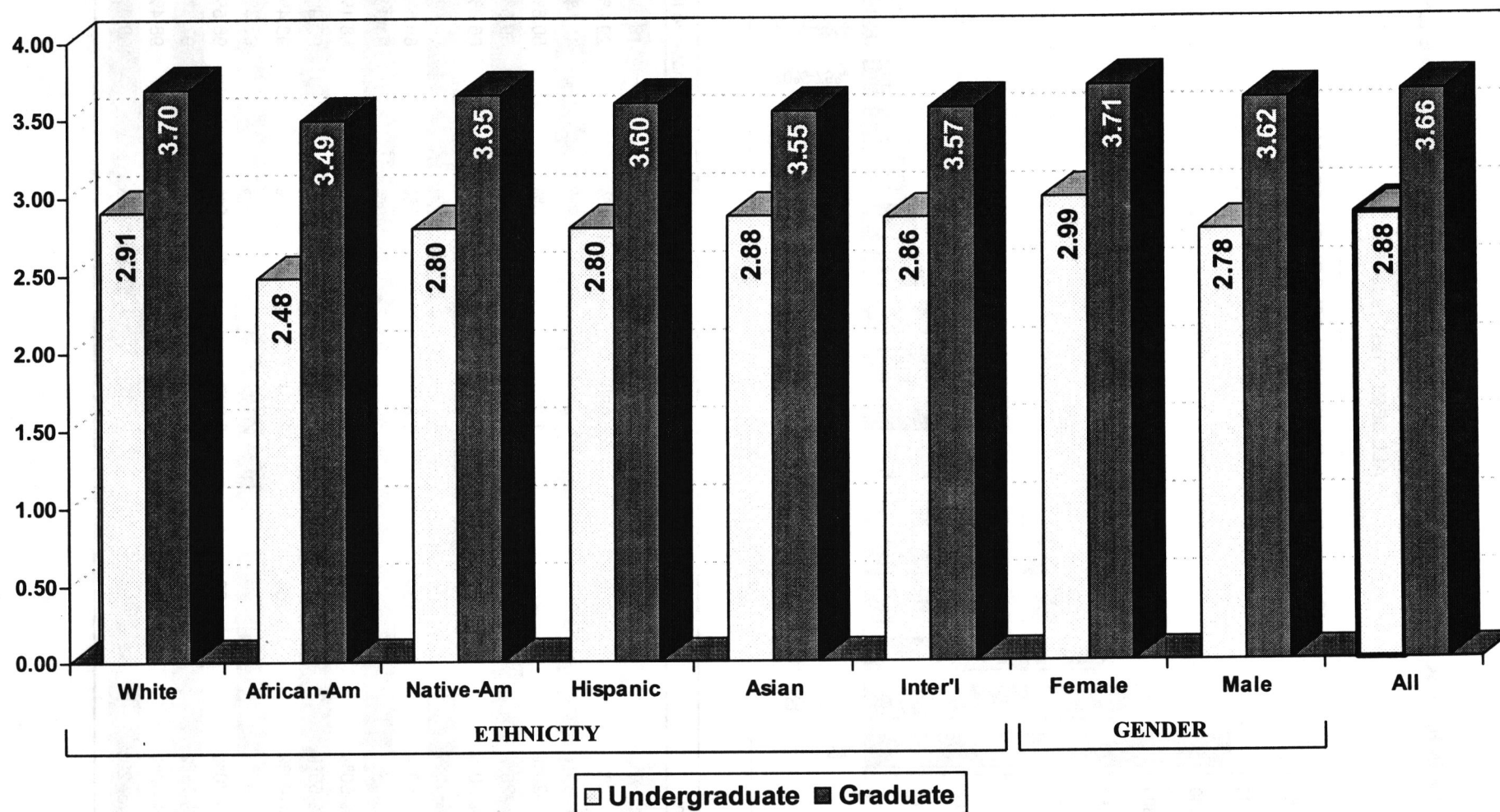

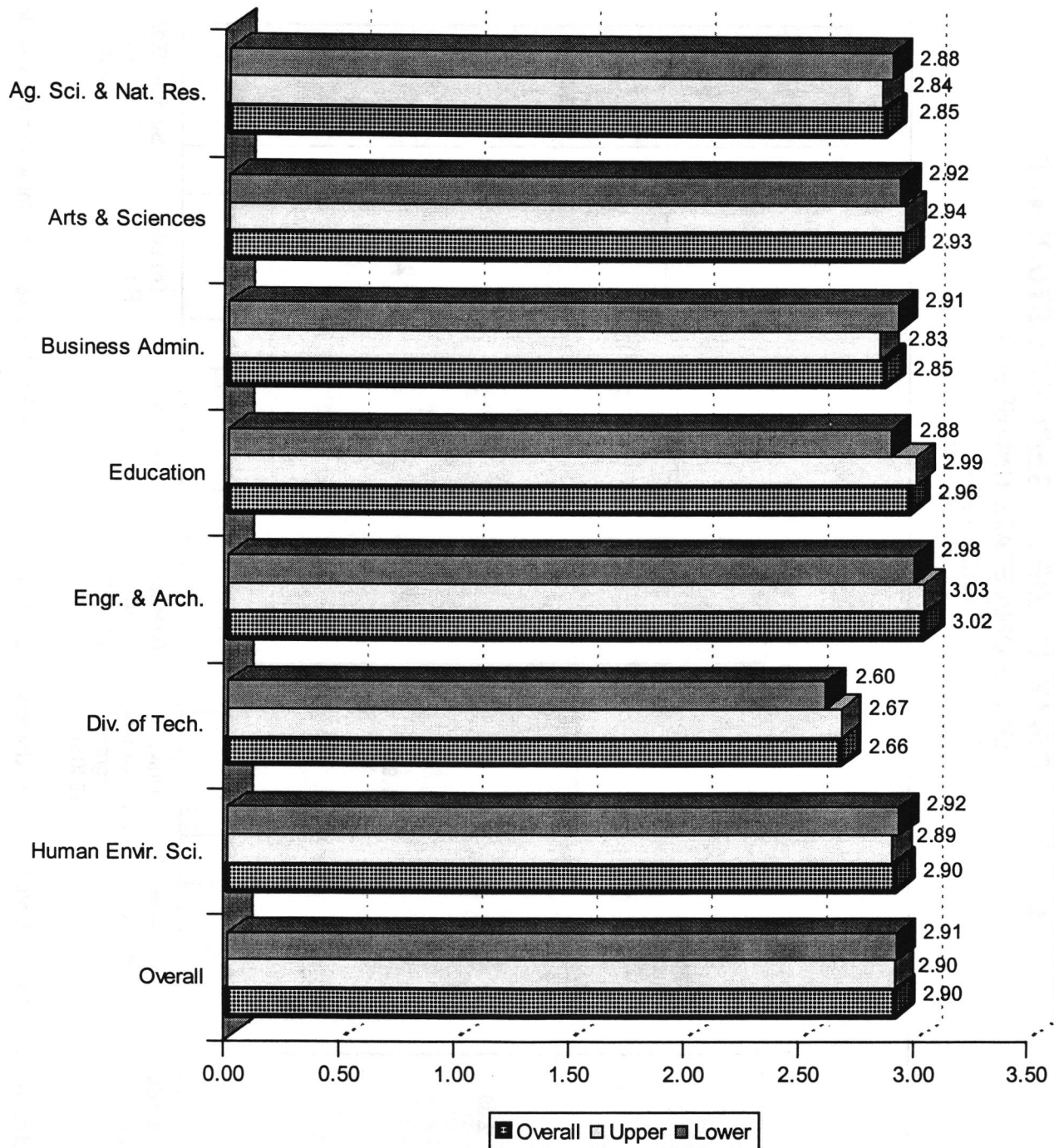

FALL 1998



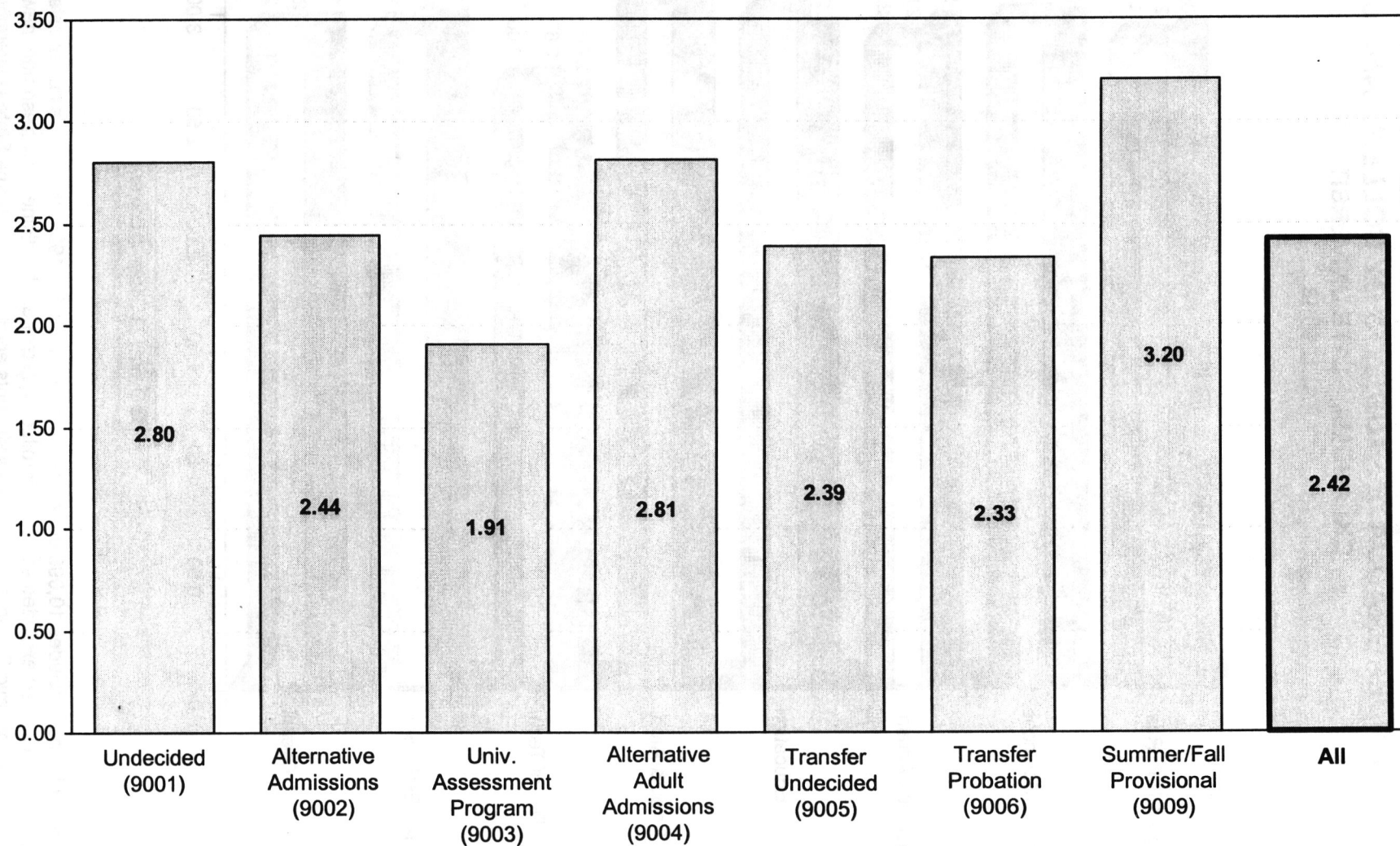

FALL 1998**



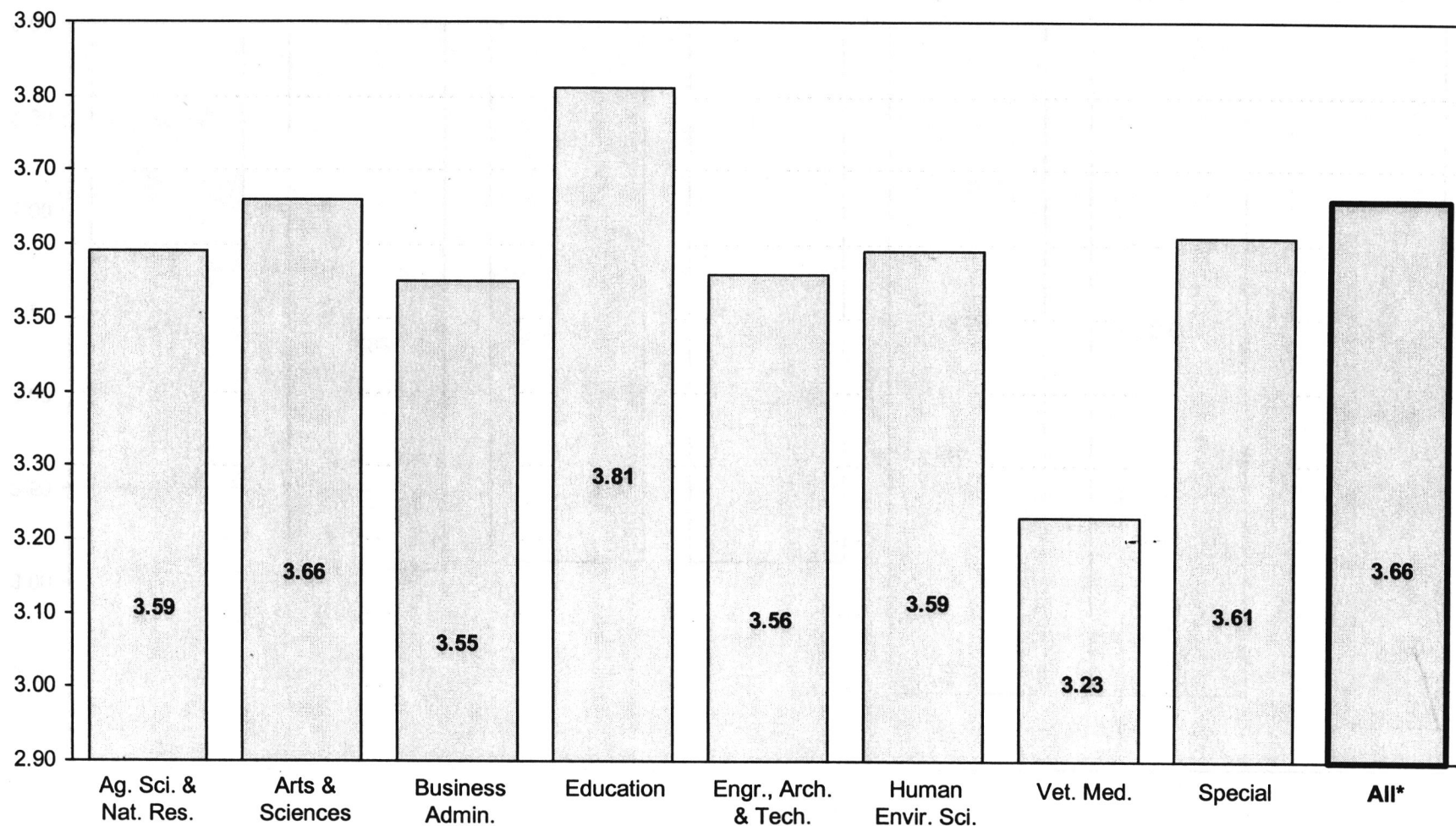

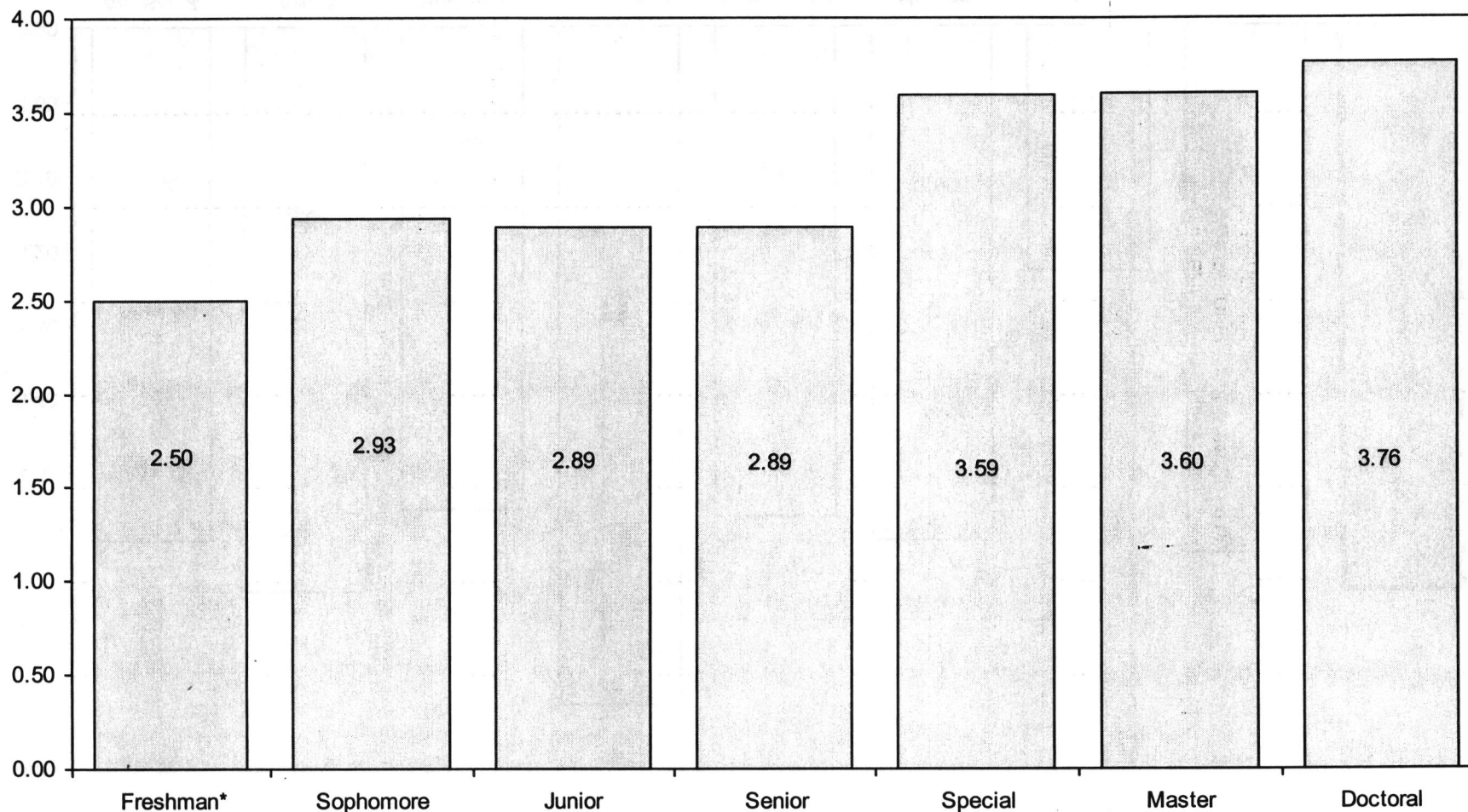
**AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE

FALL 1998**

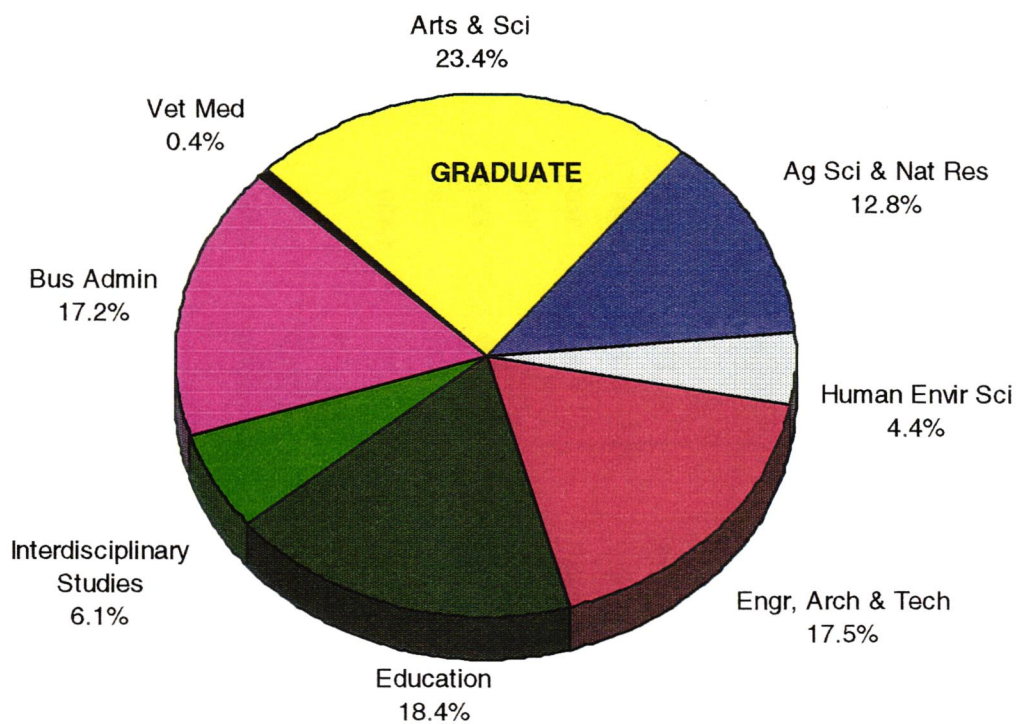
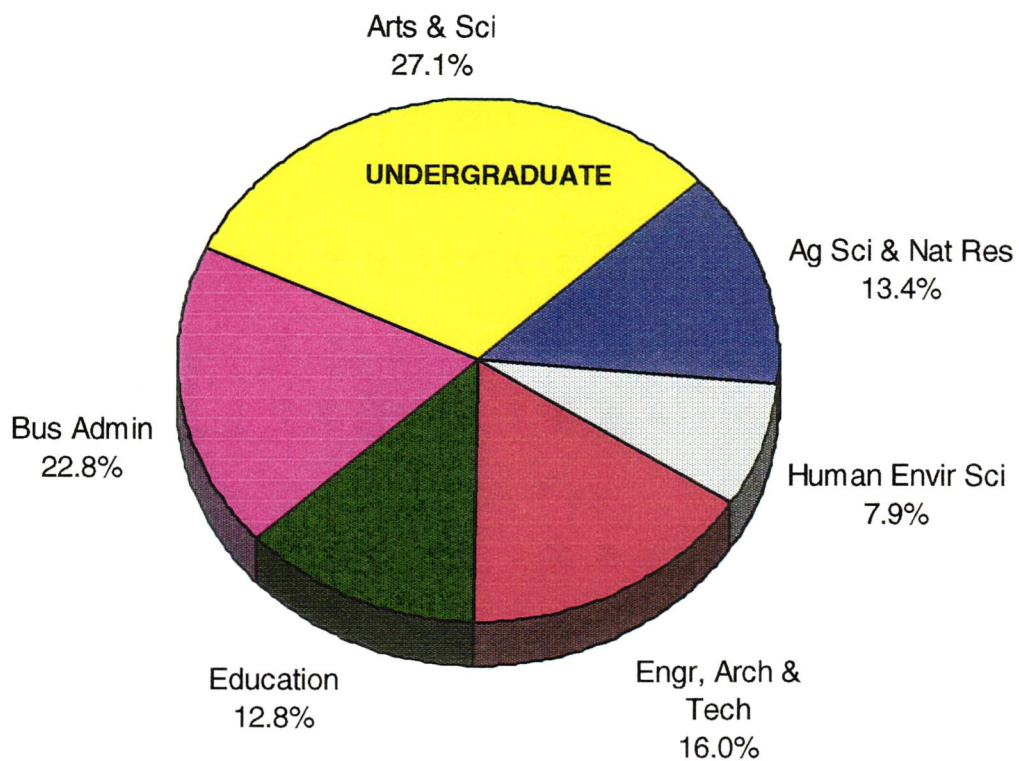

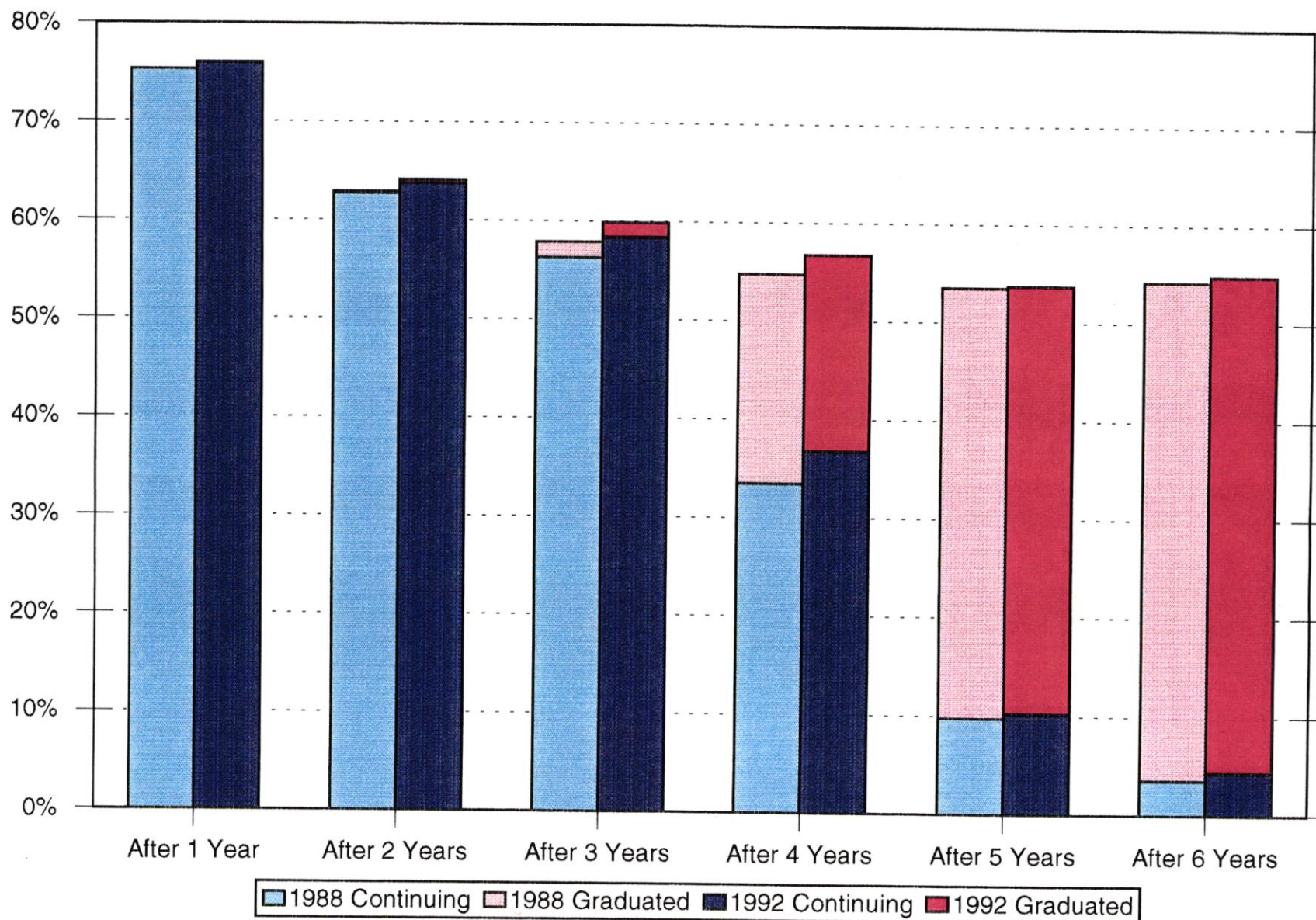

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

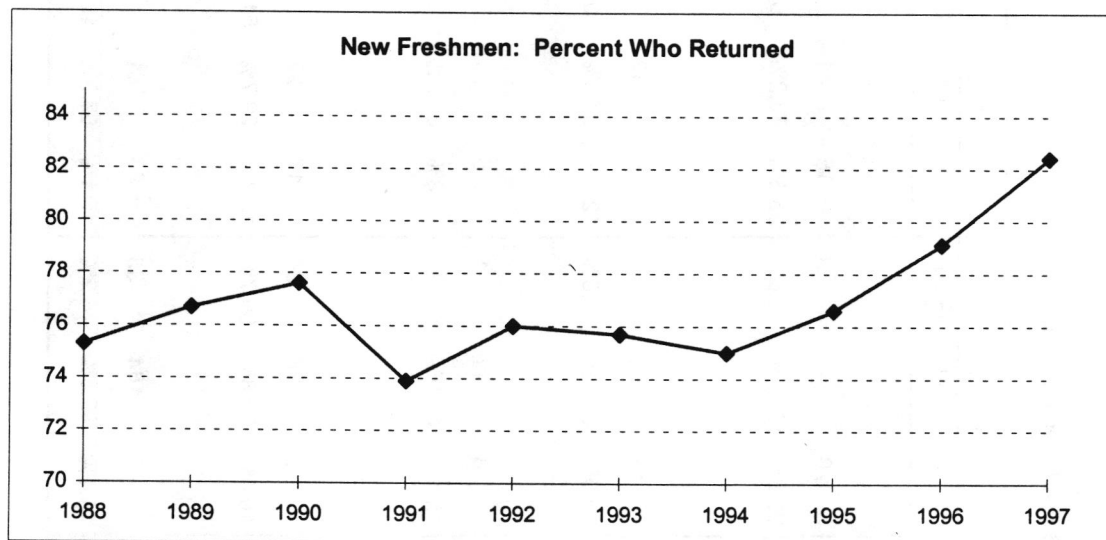

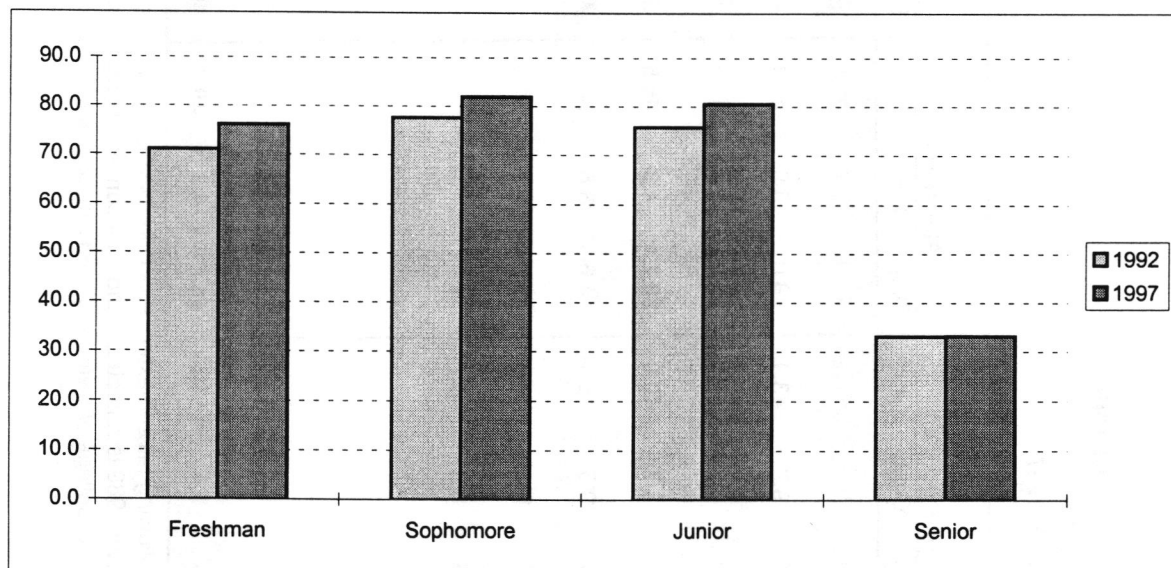

Of the Native American senior students enrolled in the Fall Semester 1997, 44.8% had gone on to graduate prior to the Fall Semester 1998.

**OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY
FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT AND PROJECTIONS**

Enrollment at Oklahoma State University increased in Fall 1998 over the previous year by 1,116 students. Undergraduate retention rates have improved significantly in the 1990's and will continue to have a large impact on enrollment numbers. The addition of OSU-Tulsa and new programs offered in Tulsa will also have a positive impact on overall enrollment in the coming years. The projections in this section are mathematical models based on past enrollments, retention rates and forecasts of high school graduates.

Forecasts for Oklahoma high school graduates show numbers increasing through the year 2000, then leveling off for several years. Since the OSU freshman class averages about 84% Oklahoma residents, these forecasts are the primary source of projection numbers for freshman enrollment. The forecasts of Oklahoma high school graduates used in this section are based upon information from the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the State Regents for Higher Education. It assumes that demographic trends such as immigration into and emigration out of the state will remain relatively constant.

Graduate enrollment at OSU continues to climb, in part due to innovative new graduate degrees. Nationally, graduate enrollments are declining. We have forecast graduate enrollment on the Stillwater campus to remain steady for the next several years.

In summary, several factors affect enrollment projections at OSU. Some of these factors depend on policy decisions originating with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and some depend on recruitment policies set by OSU administration. The impact of these policies as well as changing admissions, enrollment, retention, scholarship, and recruiting practices all have a role in determining future enrollment at Oklahoma State University. The Office of Planning, Budget & Institutional Research will continue to monitor developments in these areas and assess their impact on enrollment.

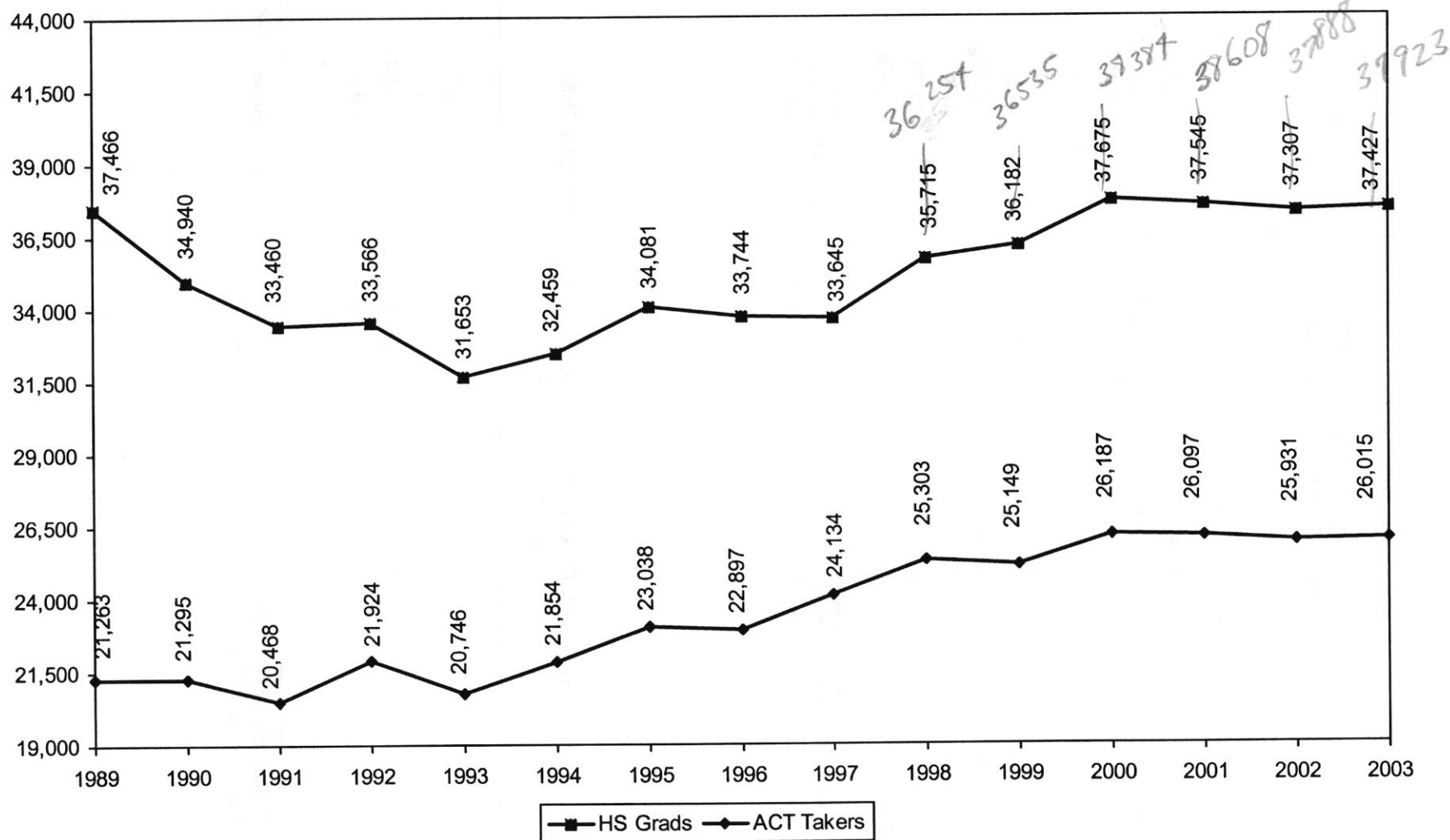

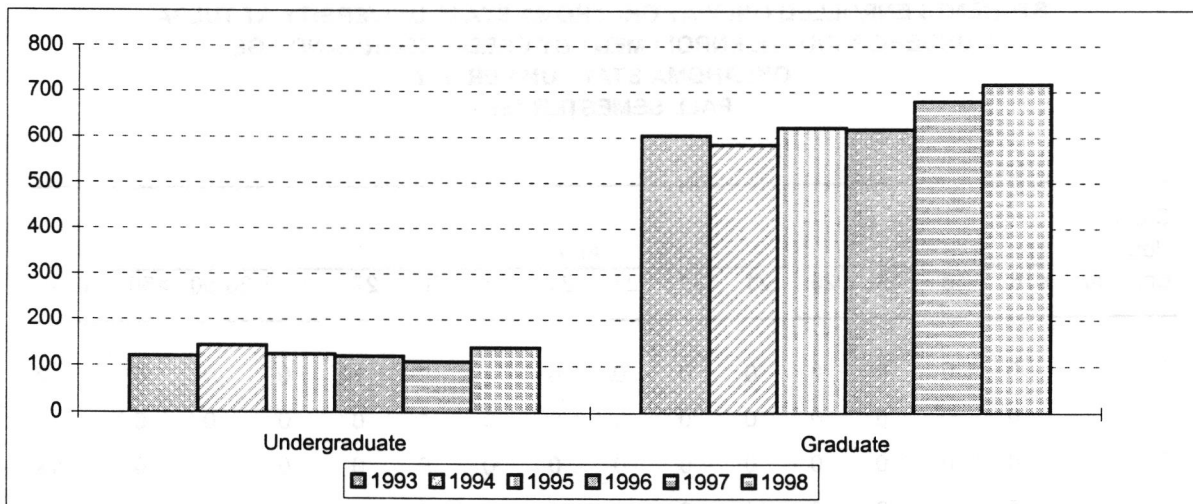

GLOSSARY

Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 1995. Therefore, students born in January 1972 and December 1972 will both be reported as age 24 (1996-1972).

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources (ASNR); Arts and Sciences (A&S); Business Administration (CBA); Education (COE); Engineering, Architecture, and Technology (CEAT); and Human Environmental Sciences (HES). Data for CEAT are sometimes divided into two data sets—one for Engineering & Architecture (ENGR), and the second for the Division of Technology (TECH).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, students may enroll in the University Academic Services, the Graduate College, and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Ethnicity Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by ethnicity, the total enrollment at OSU excluding internationals (non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

- Hispanic: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Spain or Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spaniards, and Portuguese.
- Asian: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian subcontinent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (including international students), some tables and figures which present data by ethnicity in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the international student population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a nonresident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as an international.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a non-degree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a non-degree seeking student admitted to the Graduate College.

Student Location

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File was defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as OSU-T students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at Oklahoma State University at Tulsa (2 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled at Oklahoma State University at Tulsa (0 and 1 above).

Type of Admission

A new student admitted to OSU is classified as a new freshman, a transfer student, or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).
